2021 SWIMMING POOL RULES

Use of the Crestwood Village swimming pool will be at the user's risk. The Homeowners' Association (HOA) is not responsible for any injury, illness or loss of personal property while using the pool. All injuries occurring on the premises must be reported immediately to the pool life guard, the HOA office, the Clubhouse desk or security.

POOL SEASON:

 Opening and closing: The pool opens the Saturday of Memorial Day weekend. It closes the Monday of Labor Day weekend.

Pool hours:

Monday, Wednesday and Friday	11:00 AM – 6:00 PM
Tuesday, Thursday, Sunday and Holidays*	11:00 AM - 7:00 PM
Saturday	12 Noon - 8:00 PM
*Holidays: Memorial Day, July 4th and Labor Day	

Exercise class:

SIGN-IN: All residents and their guests must sign in at the Clubhouse desk or at the lifeguard station before using the pool.

CONCERNING THE USE OF THE POOL BY RESIDENTS AND GUESTS: GENERAL INFORMATION:

- Use of the pool is prohibited unless a certified lifeguard is on duty.
- Management or the lifeguard reserves the right to close the pool at any time because of inclement weather or mechanical failure.
- Everyone must clear the pool when directed by the lifeguard for scheduled breaks, chemical testing, maintenance tasks, requested adult swim times, etc.
- No one is to enter the pool with health issues such as a cough, cold. skin disorder, open cuts, etc.
- Proper swim wear is required. No cutoffs or shorts are permitted in the pool.
- Sitting, playing or congregating on or around the stairs and railings is prohibited.
- No running, diving or jumping into the pool.
- Objects permitted in the pool are noodles, kickboards (during exercise classes only), water weights and balls in an adult-structured and supervised activity.
- Objects such as tubes, snorkels, toys, bubbles, etc. are not allowed in the pool.
- Sunbathing is confined to the pool deck level.
- No smoking or e-cigarettes are permitted.
- Inappropriate behavior of any kind will not be tolerated in the pool or surrounding areas.
- Pool rules will be posted on the fence at the pool deck entrance gate.

CONCERNING GUESTS:

- · All guests are to be in the company of an adult resident.
- EXCEPTION: Only a resident's adult children and the resident's grandchildren, may use the
 pool without the resident being on site. The responsible adult(s) under this circumstance <u>must</u>
 remain at the pool and have knowledge of and strictly comply with all Crestwood Village rules
 and regulations.
- A resident's household may have only five guests per day.

CONCERNING CHILDREN:

- Guests or resident children under the age of 18 must be in the company of and under the direct supervision of an adult resident or a resident's adult child. See the exception stated above.
- No children under the age of three are permitted in the pool. This includes sitting along the
 pool edge. Only toilet-trained children can use the pool. No diapers, swim diapers, pull-ups or
 rubber pants are allowed in the pool.
- Children may use swimming or confidence aids such as life jackets, back floats, water wings and built-in bathing suit floats as long as an adult is in the pool supervising the child using these devices.
- Sitting, playing or congregating on or around the pool stairs and railings is prohibited.
- There is to be no diving or jumping into the pool.
- There is to be no running on the pool deck level.
- Residents and their adult guests are responsible for the behavior and safety of children under their care.
- There will be a 15 minute adult swim time whenever there are 6 or more children using the pool and an adult swim time is requested by a resident.

CONCERNING FOOD AND BEVERAGES:

- Food and beverages are not permitted on the pool deck level.
- Only water in unbreakable containers is permitted on the pool deck level.
- Glass containers are strictly prohibited on the pool deck level.
- All waste is to be deposited in trash receptacles.

CONCERNING ACCESS TO THE CLUBHOUSE:

- Rear doors to the Clubhouse will be open so residents and their guests will have access to the Clubhouse locker rooms when the Clubhouse is open.
- Clothes and belongings are to be placed in Clubhouse lockers and not on benches or in the dressing areas.
- All personal belongings must be removed from the Clubhouse a half hour before the Clubhouse closes.

The lifeguard is in charge of the pool area at all times and may take any action deemed necessary for the health and safety of residents and guests.
