



MICP Marcin Bednarz #4636 Memorial Scholarship

The MICP Marcin Bednarz #4636 Memorial Scholarship Award recognizes outstanding students who have demonstrated focus on service to others and who are planning a career as an EMT or Paramedic.

Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors who plan to become EMTs or Paramedics, and preferably enroll in Bergen Community College.

Scholarship Details

- The scholarship offers two \$500 awards to graduating Clifton High School seniors
- It is sponsored through donations and the family of Marcin Bednarz, administered by the Clifton Education Foundation
- Intended for students who plan to enroll in Bergen Community College in the fall following graduation from Clifton High School and become EMTs or Paramedics
- Will be awarded annually in 2025 and 2026 and may be extended pending available funding

Eligibility Criteria

- Must be residents of Clifton, New Jersey
- Must be graduating Clifton High School seniors
- Plan to attend Bergen Community College (preferably) in the fall to become EMTs or Paramedics
- Must achieve a minimum 2.6 GPA
- Preferably, show evidence of volunteerism in the community as an EMT/EMS

Application Process

- Complete and submit the scholarship application
- Include an official Student Transcript with your application
- Include a one-page essay with your application in which you explain why you want to pursue a career as an EMT or Paramedic
