The above list includes items that are necessary for the completion of the academy. The recruit will have access to a laptop and printer. Additional supplies may be purchased at the cost of the recruit; however, they must be approved prior to use or placement on the duty belt (i.e. recording device, flashlight, flashlight case, etc.) To ensure a recruit doesn't purchase an item not authorized for use, a memo should be completed and sent to the director for review prior to purchase. Recruits may choose to use their own duty belt, equipment and weapon. If choosing to do so, recruit must send an email to the director stating their intentions and reasons why. All equipment will be subject to inspection by academy personnel. If any equipment is deemed unsafe or unacceptable, it may not be allowed to be used.
