Insect Stings and Bites.

Sting and bite prevention:

- Avoid perfumed soaps, strong scented shampoo and deodorant
- Wear clothing that covers as much of the body as possible
- Wear a medical ID if allergic to insect bites

If stung by an insect:

- Remove the stinger
- Wash the site with soap and water
- Apply ice

Avoiding Ticks:

- Avoid wooded and bushy areas with high grass
- Use repellents that lasts up to several hours
- Use products that contain 0.5% permethrin

Finding and Removing Ticks:

- Ticks can ride into the home on clothing and pets.
- Remove clothes and tumble in a dryer on high heat for an hour to kill any ticks
- Bathe or shower as soon as possible after coming indoors to wash off and easily find ticks that may be crawling on you.
- To remove a tick, use fine-tipped tweezers to grasp the tick as close to the skin's surface as possible. Pull upward with steady, even pressure

As always, if you are injured on the job, make sure it is reported to the office within 48 hours of the accident.
