### **Borough Manager's Report**

The cost of rock salt has almost doubled this year. We are working with Senator Pisciotano, Representative Inglis and County Councilman Adams to find alternatives for the SHACOG bid which is \$152.00 a ton if delivery is taken prior to October 15 and \$160.00 a ton for delivery after that. This is an 84% increase in price from last year. The Public Works may need to make some serious adjustments on how they maintain the roads this winter and the residents will need to be prepared for this.

I am working with the Jefferson Regional Foundation to strengthen its connections with the communities it serves. On November 7<sup>th</sup>, Foundation representatives will tour communities in the school district. We will discuss the Borough's history, its current conditions and needs, and how the Foundation may be able to assist. I will provide a full report after the tour.

A \$5,000 grant from Main Streets Allegheny for community events has been awarded to the Glassport Development Corp for the Annual Car Show.
