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Non-Riding Experiential Learning With Horses

Both horses and humans rely on communication to keep safe, get needs met, express emotions, and interact. As relational beings, communication is essential to our growth, development and experience of a life well lived.

What are the challenges in communicating for connection?

1. We form unconscious beliefs in the attempt to make sense of our experiences and then unknowingly engage with life from these patterns, which either join or separate us.
2. The tools and skills needed for higher level communication are not often taught or modelled so we are left with social default systems that may not work well for us as we grow.

How can we choose to get better at communicating for connection?

1. Learn tools and develop skills that support more of what you want, in a good way.
2. Discover underlying blocks that no longer serve you and start new patterns now that make it much easier to use your new tools and skills.

Come learn to more easily experience connection, navigate relationships, negotiate conflict, and benefit from experiencing positive changes during these workshops and beyond. No horse experience needed!
