Mason, who carries a 1 handicap, is currently the golf professional and general manager at the Wolcott Mill Golf Course and the Lake St. Clair Golf Course, a Wayne Metropark facility. Mason also has been a golf professional in Florida and Michigan for 35 years, handling corporate golf instruction as well as golf clinics for Detroit Lions rookies.
