Take a break from Lent and join us for a "Pub Crawl" on Winchester's Walking Mall. We have so many good places to eat and drink around the Walking Mall that it was difficult to settle on just a few. Classy Cowboy Vans is offering us round-trip transportation to the mall for only \$10 each (and a generous tip). We will start at the north end of the mall at Ellie's Irish Pub and work our way south to the 50/50 Tap House. Food and non-alcoholic drinks will be available at all our stops. Sampling flights are available in some pubs. Wearing of the Green is optional. Here is the schedule:

Kernstown Battlefield & MSV Tours, March 23, 2022



Good News! The Kernstown Battlefield has agreed to open early this year so we can tour the battlefield on the anniversary of the first battle. (Kernstown Battlefield) Normally, they are only open on weekends after April 1. Two of our Trilogy Lake Frederick neighbors, John Hess and Dan Heim, are docents at the battlefield. They will give us a tour that encompass the battlefield where both the first and second battles at Kernstown were fought as well as a tour of the Pritchard House, built in 1854 and used as a field hospital during both battles. They have golf carts for folks with limited mobility.

The Kernstown Battlefield Association, a 501(c)3 all-volunteer association, manages and maintains the grounds and buildings of this 399-acre Civil War battlefield park. They receive no funding other than donations. We will be giving them a \$20.00 per person donation for this tour. It is included in the registration for this trip.

We will have lunch at Macado's on the Walking Mall. They are famous throughout the Valley with the college crowd for their suds and sandwiches. Check out their <u>Macados</u> website. After lunch we will visit the Museum of the Shenandoah Valley (<u>MSV</u>). I am sure many of you have visited this wonderful place. Admission is free on Wednesdays. You will have ample time to explore the fixed and special exhibits. If you are not already a member, they will be happy to process your application. We should be home in time for Inglenook Happier Hour.
