DC Christmas Lights Tour December 21, 2023

Following dinner our tour guide will direct us around the city to see other lights, including the Canadian Embassy Christmas Tree, City Center decorations, and the National Christmas Tree behind the White House. We will get off the bus at some locations for a closer look on foot. Our tour guide has some surprises for us depending on how much time we spend at each site and traffic.
