#### DWIGHT HARVEST DAY PARADE COMPETITION RULES

- 1. The reviewing stand will be to the right of all parading bands.
- 2. The adjudicating area will be eighty yards to the left-center and twenty yards to the rightcenter of the reviewing stand. The corridor in the adjudicating area shall be thirty-five feet wide.
- 3. There will be one (1) STARTING LINE sign on each side of the parade route to indicate the point where bands will be adjudicated. Bands will then proceed forward passed the reviewing stand where (1) END LINE sign on each side of the parade route to indicate that the adjudication area has ended.
- 4. No band shall stop its forward motion in the adjudicating are. Music must be performed in the adjudicating area. A drum cadence alone is not considered acceptable. Bands may complete one song, execute a drum roll off and begin a second selection within the adjudicating area.
- 5. Bands will be broken into the following classifications by their IHSA school enrollment:

Elementary/Middle Schools Class A – Schools under 300 students Class AA – Schools under 800 students Class AAA – Schools over 1000 students
