Police Matters

"Overnight Thefts" - the main area of concern - remain. Residential properties are often targeted for petrol type power tools, and farm buildings are always a favourite. Please ensure that "expensive" items are locked or chained when not in use. Colleagues in Shrewsbury have seen an increase in thefts from vehicles and garages on the housing estates within the town overnight and this includes expensive bicycles - which is another item that requires "bolting down" - even when in a garage.

Check that your security lights are still working and make sure you "lock up" in the evening to prevent unwanted visitors from helping themselves. If you would like me to visit and take a walk around your property, please give me a call on 07814 042410.

Following complaints from locals - there will be some Speed Enforcement Checks being conducted in both Westbury and Yockleton over the next few months.

Stay safe and please get in touch with any questions or concerns.

Please continue to lock up outbuildings and report any sightings via 101 and also via some of the excellent community Facebook pages to alert your neighbours that they are about.

I am still working as usual and if you would like me to have a walk around your property to give security advice, please get in touch. I can manage to shout over two metres but I am missing my usual cups of tea, which would be a pre-requisite for a visit!

As always, keep garages, sheds and outbuildings locked and - if possible - alarmed. Simple battery powered alarms have improved and noise is always a good deterrent if a thief has managed to get into your "Lock Up". Quad bikes and push bikes continue to be popular amongst thieves, so both need chaining up/bolting down.

Security marking can help recover stolen items and there are a number of options available. Please remain vigilant and ensure everything gets locked all the time - not just last thing at night. Keep in touch with your neighbours by telephone and - for those who use social media - post strange vehicles and unusual events. Neighbourhood Watch is nothing complicated or formal. It's just keeping an eye out, but also letting others know - including me - if you have the registration numbers of vehicles that don't look or feel right. It doesn't matter if it is via Facebook, WhatsApp or a text message. Email me and Joe Bradley via:

If you have outside lights and security lights, make sure they are working. Any garden ornaments of value or interest need to be well secured, as do power tools and garden equipment, as they remain a desirable item for opportunist night-time thieves.

Please be aware of any unusual callers to your house or area, even those who may make themselves look legitimate by offering gardening services or asking for directions. Always try and make a note of vehicle registration numbers or anything distinctive about the vehicle and callers.

The "What's on in Westbury" Facebook page is a great way to warn everyone quickly about anything suspicious and gives others the chance to be vigilant.



Easter Message: April 2021

Hallelujah, He is risen! - He is risen indeed, Hallelujah!

For two thousand years the message of Easter is a message that has the power to change lives and to bring freedom to everyone, whatever their situation. The darkness and despair of Good Friday is overcome by the joy, the hope and the brightness of the light of Easter Sunday and, of course, we cannot have the resurrection, the defeating of death and that fresh hope of Easter Sunday unless we have lived through and had the horrors of Good Friday.

Yet on Good Friday all of the disciples believed that their hopes had been dashed and that their mission was a failure. Then, once their Sabbath was over, on the third day the woman had gone to the tomb to anoint a dead body and yet what greeted them was the realisation that their mission was in fact a triumph.

Mary Magdalene is empowered and renewed by her encounter with the risen Lord and she returns to the male disciples and utters life changing words - simply saying:

"I have seen the Lord!"

The disciples had been through a traumatic time, seeing their Lord and friend beaten, humiliated and executed; they were all demoralised and sat in a closed room for fear of the Jews. They were completely overcome by their situation and drowning in sorrow and despair, and yet that one phrase "I have seen the Lord!" had life changing power. They renewed their strength, they found new life and new hope and yet their situation hadn't changed; the threat posed by the Romans and the Jews was still there, they were still wanted men. Yet this power meant that they could rise above their surroundings, they were no longer afraid and they were able to run over to the empty tomb to witness it for themselves.

If we today are prepared to "See the Lord" and to trust him, we too can rise above the gloom of the last year. For we will know that we are loved, and that nothing can separate us from that love that God has for us through Jesus Christ.

For years science has wrestled with the question "what is the meaning of life?" Well, for years Easter has been trying to shed light on this very question; the resurrection brings us hope that the "here and now" is not all that there is. It turns our mourning into dancing, it offers a hope that all of those special people that we once knew, that we have lost – actually are not lost, but we will be reunited once more.

We worship a God who is interested in the eternal and not just the temporary. He has a plan that one day our souls will all be renewed and no longer restricted by - or trapped in - our earthly bodies; creation and all the earth will be renewed too. All because of the cross of crucifixion and the empty tomb. That is the hope of the Church; that is our hope - the hope of Easter.

He breaks the power of cancelled sin, he sets the prisoner free; his blood can make the foulest clean; his blood availed for me.

SABRINA MOBILE LIBRARY

In line with Government guidance, the Mobile Libraries will be back on the road from Monday, 12 April 2021, offering Ready Reads (Click and Collect) only to begin with, where borrowers pick up a bag of staff-selected books at their normal stop. They will be doing two weeks on the road, two weeks off for the first eight weeks. We will make a decision in May 2021 about what will happen after that. The drivers will be contacting all their borrowers to let them know and to take orders for their Ready Reads.

No stops have changed the route number or day over the last year, although some stops have changed their timings slightly (to extend or reduce the stop time, depending on how busy it is), so I would advise everyone to check the timings on the Mobile Library "Stops Map" on our website:

Dear All,

I cannot guite believe it has been nearly four years since I was elected as the Shropshire Councillor for the Loton division, which of course includes the communities of Westbury and Yockleton. Much has happened in this time, not least during the past 12 months with all of us adapting to meet the challenges of a global pandemic. It might sound like a cliché, but it has been a privilege to represent you all, and I very much hope to continue to do so for another four years after the local elections on 6th May 2021.

Many people within the community regularly collect litter in and around our villages, but I am sure it not escaped your attention that many of the major roads around the county have huge amounts of litter along their verges. I am pleased that Shropshire Council has put together a programme to litter pick these fast roads, including the A5 dual carriageway through to the Nesscliffe bypass, the A458 from Churncote to the Welsh border and the B4386 as far a Yockleton, as well as others a little further afield. This will be taking place over the next six weeks.

<u>Local Plan</u>: In the coming months the Local Plan will move forward to the next stage before being formally adopted next year. I can confirm that Westbury will remain Open Countryside Status and that no changes have been made to this Status following the latest consultations which have been running. This time last year, things were not quite as certain, however I do not see any changes coming about before the Plan is considered by the Planning Inspector.

Households in Westbury Parish will soon be receiving a free SmartWater kit purchased uniquely for their household by your local Parish Council working alongside the "We Don't Buy Crime" team and West Mercia Police to **protect your home from burglary**.

Due to the current restriction of Covid-19 and the need to self-isolate, this kit has been safely pre-registered to your address and **this solution is now unique to your home.** This procedure is in line with Royal Mail General Data Protection Regulations/Guidelines; however should you wish to opt out of this initiative, simply email:

and we will remove the kit/your record from the initiative.

Why protect your items with SmartWater?

If your items were stolen, the Police could trace them back to you. By SmartWater protecting your items, you deter a burglary.
