Police Matters

Hopefully everyone will have noticed that the team from SmartWater have been out putting up the large blue signs notifying would-be thieves that Westbury and Yockleton is an area protected by Smart-Water, following the commitment by Westbury Parish Council to help fund the project last year. Hopefully everyone who received their pack in the post has used it and - more importantly - put the stickers in their windows to show that their home is protected. If anyone needs help in using their kit or wants advice, please get in touch with us at Pontesbury Police Office.

We are currently dealing with a high volume of incidents. Sadly we have seen quad bikes being stolen overnight and also another farm premises being targeted, so the night time thieves are still about, so make sure everything is locked up and bolted down overnight. Check that your security lights are still working and make sure you "lock up" in the evening to prevent unwanted visitors from helping themselves.

Following complaints from locals - there will be some Speed Enforcement Checks being conducted in both Westbury and Yockleton over the next few months.

Stay safe and please get in touch with any questions or concerns.

Please continue to lock up outbuildings and report any sightings via 101 and also via some of the excellent community Facebook pages to alert your neighbours that they are about.

If you would like PC Simon Lewis to have a walk around your property to give security advice, please get in touch. As always, keep garages, sheds and outbuildings locked and - if possible alarmed. Simple battery powered alarms have improved and noise is always a good deterrent if a thief has managed to get into your "Lock Up". Quad bikes and push bikes continue to be popular amongst thieves, so both need chaining up/bolting down.

Security marking can help recover stolen items and there are a number of options available. Please remain vigilant and ensure everything gets locked all the time - not just last thing at night.

Keep in touch with your neighbours by telephone and - for those who use social media - post strange vehicles and unusual events. Neighbourhood Watch is nothing complicated or formal. It's just keeping an eye out, but also letting others know, including the Police,

West Shropshire Flower Club

The Flower Club meeting in April was lucky enough to see the return of Jane Pugh, the ever popular Bishop's Castle florist. Due to "technical difficulties" at the last minute, the title of her demonstration was changed to "Chocolate Fantasy" and kicked off with a Milk Tray inspired design. The arrangement - placed in a swirling purple structure - held lush foliage dressed with a flow of purple Lisianthus through the middle, into which was added Allium bursts and a gorgeous lilac Carnation called Moonaqua, all set off with recessed Statice and the arrangement was completed with a box of Milk Tray chocolates.

As soon as the tall open metal base filled with orange Sisal was placed on the stand, most guessed that next up was a chocolate orange. Jane placed long orange-dyed Pussy Willow and soft Ruscus in a dramatic horizontal, then added mass centrally with chocolate coloured Hebe. Into this, orange spray Carnations and flame-tipped orange Roses took up the orange theme, which was added to with soft orange Tulips, again accompanied by a chocolate orange. "Mint Aero" was an all-round arrangement in the softest bubbly greens of Skimmia, Euphorbia, Spiraea, Gypsophila and mint green Conifer, with striking Chrysanthemum Anastasia and Carnation Prado Mint (and yes you guessed it - with a bar of Aero). The next truly tropical arrangement was "Bounty", a lush tropical foliage of Laurel, Fatsia and rolled Aspidistra leaves nestled in huge dried Palm Spathes. Building on the wave theme, electric blue Delphinium created a vertical element, to which coconut white Avalanche Roses were added, with a final tropical touch of a Cymbidium Orchid (and a Bounty). Her final Flake arrangement was a large asymmetric arrangement reflecting the accompanying Flake wrapper with purple Lisianthus, Clematis and Veronica Spires, yellow Roses, Genista and Freesias linked with beautiful purple Iris with a yellow throat. The addition of chocolates to each arrangement was an added bonus to those winning the raffled arrangements!!

Dear All

It certainly feels like Spring has arrived and - as we move into Summer - we look forward to the many events that are planned across our Parishes to celebrate The Queen's Platinum Jubilee. I very much hope to attend as many events as possible over the course of the weekend and a big Thank You goes to the Organising Committees who are pulling these together.

In rural areas, fly tipping is a significant problem and I am pleased to say that a dedicated Fly Tipping Response Team is taking to the roads from 1st April 2022 as Shropshire Council looks to clamp down on unsightly and illegally dumped waste. The team will be out and about five days a week in a new fly tipping response vehicle, following up reports of fly tipping on public land, and looking for cases that have yet to be reported. They will clear fly tips – or arrange for them to be cleared – and will also look for and record evidence which will enable the offenders to be identified and prosecuted. If you spot anything, please let me know or report it through the Council's website.

The first phase of the Road Re-surfacing Programme has been completed and we have seen significant stretches re-surfaced including the Alberbury road, the Westbury to Halfway House road and Montford, but there is still more to do on the A5 to Westbury stretch and this is scheduled for this month. As the Summer progresses, we will see other areas surface-dressed which is where the road is sealed and sprayed with chippings; this should cause less disruption than the full re-surfacing, but it is certainly welcomed. I know there is still a long way to go but at last it does feel as though there is some progress.

Council Tax Rebate for Band A-D properties. Those of you who pay their Council Tax by direct debit should start to see the Rebate land in your bank accounts over the coming weeks. There is a lot to process and it is being done in batches. The easiest way to get the Rebate is to be registered to pay Council Tax by direct debit, as then the Council has your details. For those who do not pay by direct debit, information will follow on how to claim your Rebate. Any problems with this, please let me know.

If you missed to order your new recycling bin, applications are now open again. For those who ordered in the first round, the bins will be delivered over the Summer and roll out is starting in the south of the County shortly.


Covid 19 Virus

You may of course book for 12 months @ £30.00*. If you book for a year in advance, you get a "secure placement" which will carry on for as long as you want it to, subject to your paying the renewal invoices on time. New adverts start on the back page and - month by month move forward column-by-column towards page two, after which they re-start at the back. This ensures that all businesses receive equal coverage throughout the year. As there is a small turnover in the adverts, they will also slowly move up and down the page. Printing will be in full web colours

Before sending me your advert PRINT this sheet out and make sure your advert fits the relevant box and is readable at that size.

For secure slots, I will email a single "invitation to renew" invoice once your last paid for advert is published. I will not publish an advert which is unpaid after the expiry date on the invoice. If you pay late, you are at risk of losing the secure slot.

PAYMENT

We cannot accept payment by BACCs or Credit or Debit cards - only Cheques which need to be drawn in favour of Westbury Village Hall (who provide us with banking facilities) but posted to me at the address given below so that I may photocopy each cheque for my Newsletter records before passing it on to our Village Hall Committee's Treasurer to be credited to our Sub-Account within their main account.

Please let me know which size advert you prefer and for how many months you wish to book, so that I can then invoice you – it would be good to get your advert into our next issue. However, we do require receipt of payment <u>before</u> we place an advert.

For our records, I need the name of your business, your postal address, your email address and your landline and mobile telephone numbers. We are no longer able to absorb postal charges within the above costings. If you cannot provide me with an e-mail address to send your invoices, I need to add a charge to each invoice to cover the cost of posting a paper copy. The initial invoice will carry a charge of £2 to cover itself and the first renewal invoice. Subsequent renewal invoices will carry a £1 charge to cover the next renewal invoice. If you need a receipt on paper, please enclose a stamped addressed envelope with your payment.

Several of the businesses have stated that they find our Newsletter is a very cost-effective advertising platform and we appreciate the financial support we gain from them as we are running the Newsletter on a voluntary basis with no grant from Westbury Parish Council or any other funding or any profit.
