Chapter 19: Excel

Function: It is a special type of formula with a pre-defined name, that is built into the software/ They are used to simplify complicated calculations.

Formula: A formula can be a simple calculation/mathematical operation and can be typed directly into the formula bar. A formula can contain a function.

Why is a named range used in a spread sheet?

-You can easily refer to a group of adjoining cells, thus shortening the formulae since it enables you to refer to a group of cells without having to lookup cell references or re-set the absolute referencing manually.

Use of hyperlinks:

To navigate from one place/page to another

When used with a website, absolute and relative file paths can be explained as:

Relative path points to current folder « so relative links uploaded to server will work

Absolute file path points to a location on a storage device «so links uploaded to server unlikely to work (unless same structure)

Brackets have highest priority so are calculated first Exponents/indices have second priority (powers and roots) Division and multiplication are next Last are addition and subtraction

Identify two methods of testing a web page: Functional testing / alpha testing / in-house

A spreadsheet program is ELECTRONIC PAPER -- also called a **WORKSHEET**. With MS Excel, you can have multiple worksheets contained in a **WorkBook** (a single Excel file).

The workplace is divided into **COLUMNS** and **ROWS**.

COLUMNS traditionally are designated by one or two letters (starting with A). Columns are vertical. (up and down).

ROWS are generally identified by numbers (starting with 1). Rows go across.

The **INTERSECTION** of a row and column is called a **CELL**.

A CELL is typically referred to by its column and row designation (A1 or Z56 or AA345 or VK987) which is its unique **ADDRESS** within the total spreadsheet.

A cell may contain one of three types of entries:

- 1. Numbers or *values* (numeric data)
- 2. Labels (alphabetic or alphanumeric data)
- 3. *Formulas* (expressions of calculations or relationships among cells)

Why is it important to enter accurate data in spreadsheets?

- -To make sure data is identical to original document
- -If one data is wrong, all data in the spreadsheet would be wrong
- -one small error in the formula would likely stop the spreadsheet working as it is expected to.

The cascading stylesheets are part of the **Presentation** layer in website development.

Hyperlinks are an action in a web page and they are part of the **Content/Structure** layer.

The text and images of a web page are added to a web page in the **Content/Structure** layer.

An action like 'hover over' or 'on click' would be found in the Behaviour/Scripting layer.

Fonts match the style in company logo
Fonts may be part of corporate house style.
Font colour matches that in logo for style h1.
Fonts are script fonts so are more difficult to read.
Poor contrast between text & background

File has been changed from PNG file settings of 16 bits/channel to a JPG/GIF file of 8 bits per channel. This reduces storage space and image transmission time by about ½.

- Browser searches (through available fonts) for the font Times (and if found it is displayed).
- If the font Times is not available, browser searches for "Times New Roman"
- If neither is available, browser uses its pre-defined/default generic serif font.
- Speech marks are around "Times New Roman" to define it as a single string/so it does not search for Times

Evaluate:

- I have used data <u>validation</u> to restrict the data entry
- Data entry is restricted to <u>only</u> the items entered in <u>source list/range of cells</u>
- My validation rule only caters for lower case letters/should allow upper case letters
- My validation rule should not allow a blank cell in B4 as it could cause an error

Suggestion

- List source in validation rule should be extended to include D and W
- Remove tick box for 'ignore blank'/ prevent B4 containing no data

Improvement

- Improvement print screen, showing D and W added to accepted validation
- ignore blank tick removed if error mentioned above

Resizing in web page takes longer to load as full image is downloaded.


