YOUTH DIVISIONS

Youth divisions were officially added on April 27! Opening up our race to the next generation of multisport racers!

We have been inspired by the youth in the Kids That Tri program to create these specific divisions for youth aged 13-15 & 16-19 who are interested in racing Triathlon or Duathlon at our race.

Due to USA Triathlon sanctioning for Tri CLE, youth participants ages 13-19 will be racing the standard Super Sprint, Sprint, and Olympic courses at the same time as the adult participants. There will not be a separate youth course.

Each youth participant should be comfortable racing these distances and also understand road markings, signage, and other race-specific directions.

USA TRIATHLON LEVEL 1 CERTIFIED RACE DIRECTORS

Natalie McManamon (Event Director) and Melanie Prohaska (Marketing & Communications Director) became USA Triathlon Level 1 Certified Race Directors. Our team is now trained to understand the details of what it takes to prepare, set up, and put on a safe race.

Craig Thompson (HFP Racing), who is a USAT Level II Certified Race Director who has extensive experience with putting on multisport races has been giving us great guidance and we will continue to utilize his services to make sure we address the necessary details to put on our race.

Even with Craig's expertise at our fingertips, we felt it was important to have Natalie & Mel each obtain this certification as they are located here in Northeast Ohio and are able to meet in person with local officials, review the race course easily, and are able to connect with the community.
