This was challenging because most of the students were doing online learning in learning due to the pandemic and adding these sessions required a lot of tenacity. Our topics were **Etiquitte, Self Esteem, boundaries, Leadership, Health Living, Priorities and Social Media.**

In summer of the same of the same year we hosted an in-person 2 **day Level 2 Teen Confidence Keys** in collaboration with Transcend Stem Education workshop at Ard Properties in Garland Tx. Mr Wesley Ard who owns the property was gracious enough to let us rent some space at a very low cost.

We focused on **Fashion**, How to be endy and still be modest. how to chose

friends wisely. You are who you hang around with. Family how to be helper in **Communication** open. Teens tend to be so far removed because they spend time on their gadgets. Unplugging and being present with the family is very healthy. Reading the word of God and practicing **Faith** amongst our peers helps students not easily succumb to peer pressure.

Sex is a very sensitive topic but we created a safe space to talk about it by teaching the girls as to why God created sex. Who it was created for and in what season of life. It is important for us to present the gospel without compromising the truth. The world is teaching about safe sex. We teach about abstinence.
