As we come to the end of 2019 there are no words enough to describe God's faithfulness and provision since 2014 through to this day. In 2015 Girls Set Apart became a non profit organization from an IIc which allows us to solicit for donations. We are thankful to our team members Mr John Bagdasarian who helped in writing our articles and Mrs Polly Haley who also helped in the process.

Our goal and vision has always been to minister and mentor girls. We were able to add a teen mentoring program for our high school girls as they transitioned from The Princess In Me to the Teen Girls Ministry. We celebrate all our 6th grade graduates with a big banquet style every year. Parents and close family members get to attend this celebration. In the Teen Ministry they are equipped to serve and develop into leaders in society. They gradually take on some leadership responsibilities as "BIG SISTERS" which entails, mentoring and being exemplary models to younger girls. Teens face

many challenges during their middle school to high school years. Trying to fit in socially, economically, and even intellectually is the center of their era. It is proven that the most crucial time of a child during their adolescent years. The teen ministry gives them a platform to share the challenges they face without fear of being judged

As a ministry we have been able to share the biblical truth as a guide to their daily lives by making the Bible relatable. We teach them to know that; Christianity is about what God has done for them. We teach them the truth about Who Christ is; Who they are in him and why he created them (*PURPOSE*) It is important to help our students by giving them tool that prepares

them to conquer the world even if they stumble and fall, they can get back up boldly to carry on.

Through workshops, retreats and in home gatherings we have ministered to approximately 200 girls in total. By welcoming students from all walks of life and that has given us an opportunity to mentor students from different backgrounds, Christians or non Christians.

Every event has been graced by proffessional community leaders who have a heart, desire and calling of empowering today's youth. They come in as workshop presenters or guest speakers and authentically share their personal experiences to help the students understand that life is a cycle that has been walked before, and they too can make it. Most of all, fun is always part of our gatherings and everything we do with our students. Games, talent shows, runways, have been had. This has helped many of our students come out of their shells and be just themselves, the best they can be. Lives have been transformed.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

Our organization was recognized as Community Organization Of The year by the Zimbabwe Achievers Association in 2016. We are forever grateful. In 2019 our CEO and founder Leah Chikumbindi was awarded Womenprenuer Of The Year and Proverb 31 Woman by This And That Love Organization Of Dallas. We are truly blessed to be a part of a larger community that recognize our efforts and cheers us on.

Over the course of the 5yrs we have also partnered with Family Promise of Collin County and Hope's Door of Plano which offers temporary accommodation to homeless families by inviting children in their programs to come and be part of our events and workshops free of charge. Children should not feel forgotten, disconnected or displaced while going through situations that are beyond their control. In the same effort, we were able to put care packages together for Fosterkids Charity Organization, an organization that helps underpreviledged students in foster care by providing snacks when kids come to their facilities.

As part of our Missions Project, Our Princess In Me Royal Retreat participants have managed to help kids who are going through temporary homelessness by donating winter socks and undergarments to Hope's Door in Plano. They participate in community activities and different platfor talking about Domestic Violence and bringing awareness to the youth and finding ways to combat this and other issues that silently affect children and families in our communities today.


