Rules and Regulations

Graves

- We permit one internment and one inurnment, or two inurnments per grave
- Only bronze markers are allowed to be placed on graves
 - o Four Evangelists Garden Section:
 There are a limited number of graves available in the Four Evangelists Garden where we will permit upright monuments. You must purchase a two-grave lot to receive permission to place an upright monument
 - o *Garden of Peace Section*: Bronze markers and pillow-top monuments are permitted on all graves in the Garden of Peace
 - Columbariums: Each niche is 12 inches squared. You may have up to two sets of ashes inurned in each niche, so long as both containers fit
 - Cremation Garden: Only one set of ashes may be inurned per grave. Bronze markers only
 - Cremation Benches: Up to four sets of ashes may be inurned in each bench
- All markers shall be installed by cemetery personnel
- No borders shall be placed around markers
- Plantings are only allowed with permission. See the office staff to request permission
- We reserve the right to remove any plants, or other embellishments which are unsightly or pose a hazard.
- Families are solely responsible for watering newly seeded graves

Internments

- All lots are sold in accordance with the provisions of the laws of the State of New York and shall not be used for any other purposes than as a burial place for dead human beings
- Lot owners are prohibited from allowing internments to be made on their lots for compensation
- No internment shall be allowed without permission from the Superintendent or his designee. At the time of application for permission, the following information must be furnished:
 - o Name of deceased
 - o Age of deceased, including date of birth if known
 - Place of birth of deceased, if known
 - o Date of death
 - o Time and date of internment
 - If not an adult, names of parent(s) or legal guardian(s)
- Disinterments shall be allowed between the first of June and the thirtieth of September, provided there is compliance with all provisions of N-PCL §1510(e), Concrete burial vaults or grave liners are required for burials on all lots purchased on or after January 1, 1985

Lot Purchase and Transfer

- The full purchase price must be paid before a deed will be issued or a burial allowed on a lot
- Except as provided for in N-PCL §
 1513(c), no lot owner may transfer his or
 her lot

Rules and Regulations

Ashes

• There shall be no scattering of ashes anywhere on cemetery property

Decorations and Embellishments

- We reserve the right to remove all flowers, wreaths, or other decorations from lots as soon as they become unsightly
- We reserve the right to remove any embellishment on the lot or effigy which is dangerous or unsightly
- We reserve the right to restrict the planting of shrubs and trees, and to remove any shrub or tree, deemed dangerous to the public, upon due notice to the lot owner.
- Planting of glass blocks or vases as receptacles for flowers on graves or plots is prohibited
- April 1st October 1st
 - o One flower pot per grave is permitted
 - o Flower pots must be at least 8" wide and no more than 24" wide
 - All flowers and other decorations must be placed inside the flower pot
 - All decorations not removed by October 1st will be removed by cemetery personnel
- November 1st March 1st
 - o One wreath per grave is permitted
 - o Wreath must be placed on a wreath stand at least 36" tall
 - All decorations not removed by March 1st will be removed by cemetery personnel
- Seven days before Memorial Day June 15th
 - Flags may be placed in the ground at the grave

Outside contractors

- No outside contractors are permitted to do any work on the cemetery grounds
- All work on the cemetery grounds shall be performed by cemetery personnel

Grounds

 All funeral, processions, and vehicles will be under the control of the Superintendent while on cemetery property

Funerals

- Must arrive at the cemetery by 2pm
- Overtime charges apply after 3pm and on Saturdays
- All funeral processions, vehicles, and attendees shall abide by any and all instructions given to them by cemetery personnel

Chapel

- Available to the public during office hours, unless previously rented
- Available to rent; see office staff with questions

Animals

 No domestic animals permitted on cemetery property, including dogs
