Executive Summary

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MISSION: The K-Ready Community Project is committed to making early childhood a top priority in Orange County, building a better system of care and education to ensure that EVERY child has a strong start and a bright future.

WHY K-READY?

- **A Strong Start is Key to Future Success** – The best way to build broad prosperity is to invest in the education and well-being of children during the critical early years to prepare them for success in school and life. Yet, in Orange County, almost **half** of children start kindergarten NOT ready.
- **Childcare is Essential** – Working parents, especially women, need reliable childcare options so they can work and earn a living. Yet childcare is unaffordable for most families, often costing more than rent or food, and subsidies to help families cover the cost of high-quality care are inadequate.
- **Inequity Starts Early** – Black and Hispanic women and children and those from low-income families are less likely to have access to prenatal care, insurance, and quality early learning options, and children are more likely to enter kindergarten without the skills needed for success.

A UNIQUE APPROACH: The K-Ready Community Project is a collective impact movement and systems approach that is driving transformative change for early childhood. Our unique approach follows three steps: 1) Develop a clear-eyed understanding of where we are now and commit to a vision for a better future. 2) Bring leaders and stakeholders together to take collaborative action for systemic change. 3) Build a broad K-Ready Alliance to advocate for policy and funding changes at the local, state, and federal levels.
