!W. Soles recieved 200 acres as a settler in 1790 Matilda Township. He was a soldier of the Loyal Rangers- "Jessop's Ranger's" Loyalist Lists by E. Keith Fitzgerald p 87. The settlement of Upper Canada by William Canliff.

! William Sole was born in 1730 in Albany, Albany, NY. Annie May Mitchell (nee Nelson) said that the first Soles fought with General Wolfe at The Battle of the Plains of Abraham. After the war, instead of returning to the old country he accepted a land grant at Kingston, near the old prison. We assumed that it was Kingston, Ontario, but it seems that it was Kingston, New York.

Old Loyalist Lists records recordss two William Soules (Sowils) and one John Sowlis, who was the son of of William Soules SR. - no relationship for the William Sowils Jr. - however it is quite possible that he is a son of William Sowlis Sr. from a previous marriage? W. Soles apparently received 200 acres as a settler in 1790 Matilda Twsp. He was a soldier of the Loyal Rangers - "Jessop's Rangers" Albany Dutch Reformed Church Birth Records 1683-1809 p 379 (note: this record records father's name as William Fool (Tool). Birth date recorded as Mar 1 (4) 1763.
