D. Website & Technology Data

- IP address and browser type
- Pages visited on our website
- Information submitted through online forms

2. How We Use Information

We use collected information to:

- Provide educational services and instruction
- Support student academic and personal development
- Communicate with parents and guardians
- Process enrollment and tuition payments
- Coordinate counseling and student support services
- Comply with legal and regulatory requirements
- Improve our programs, services, and website

3. Sharing of Information

We do not sell or rent personal information.

We may share information only as necessary with:

- Authorized school staff and administrators
- Service providers (e.g., student information systems, payment processors)
- Government agencies or scholarship programs (e.g., NCSEAA) as required
- Licensed counselors or clinical supervisors involved in student care
- Legal authorities when required by law

4. Student Privacy & Confidentiality

We take student privacy seriously.

- Educational records are handled in accordance with applicable privacy laws.
- Counseling information is kept confidential and shared only as permitted by law or with parent/guardian consent, except where disclosure is required for safety or legal reasons.
