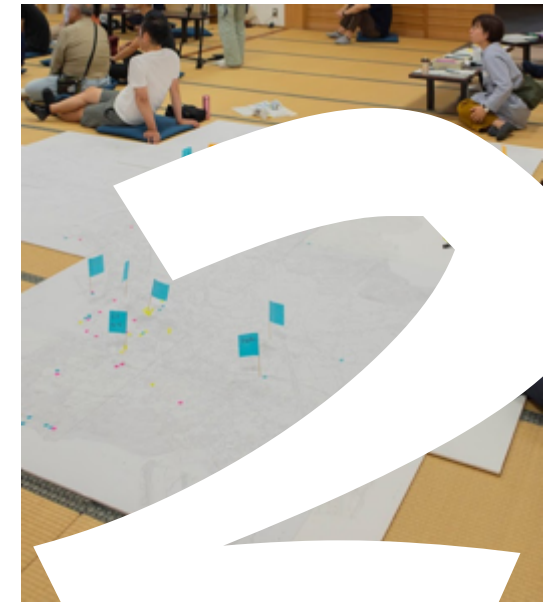
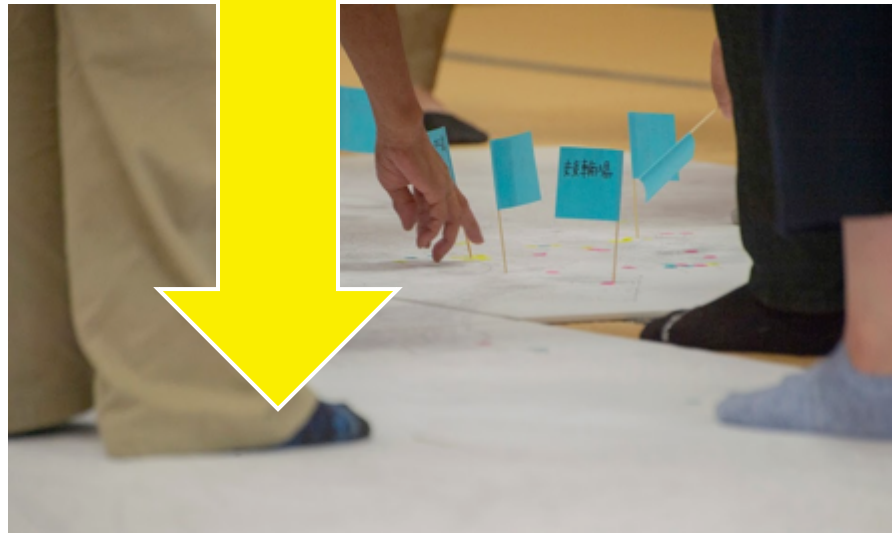


# Kichoff program summary DAY1 :Brainstorming NEW Ideas

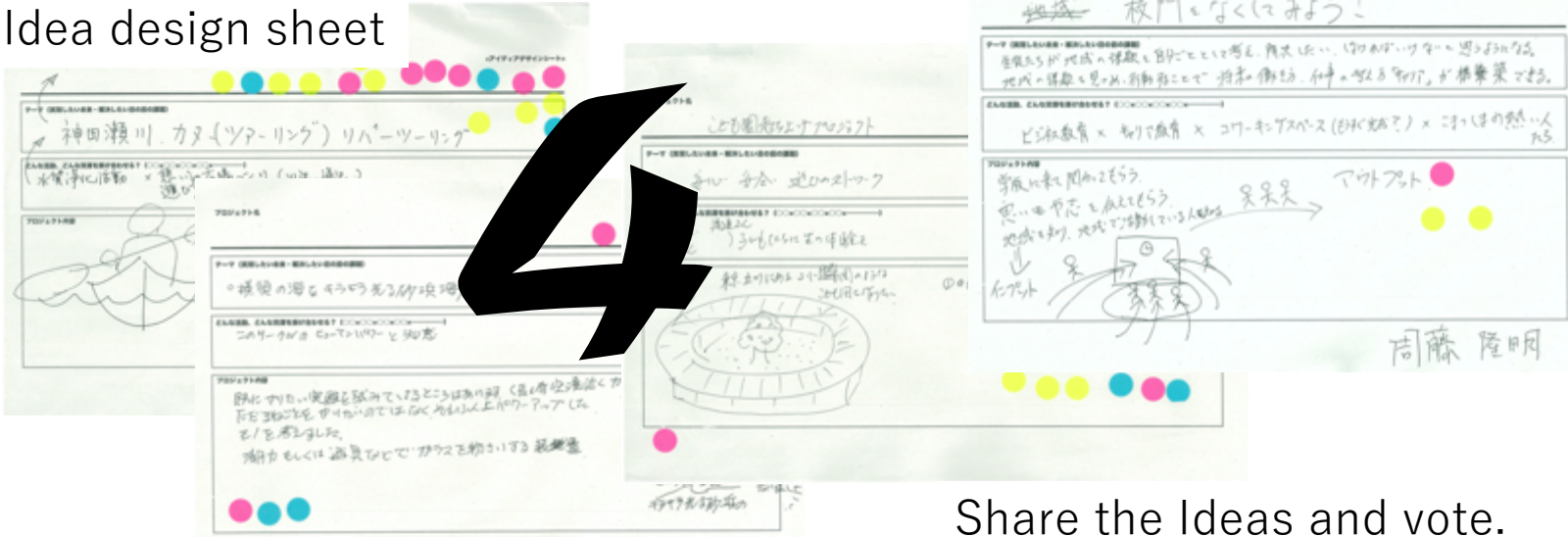

Building strong relationship by Information Technology

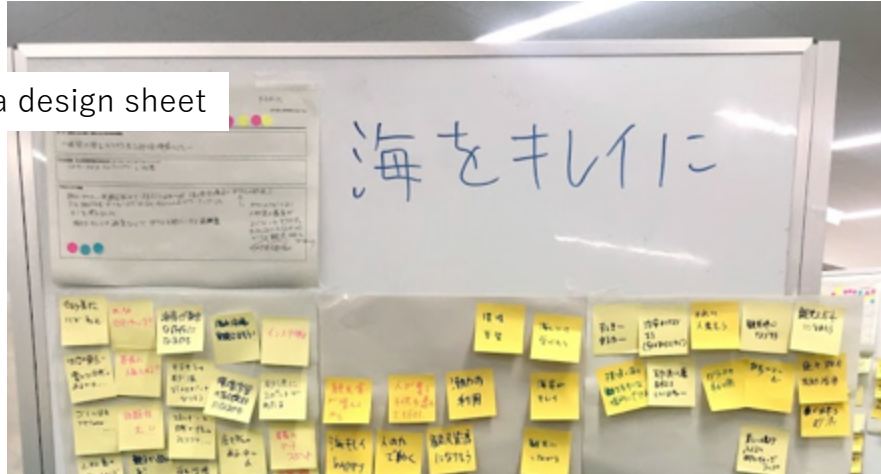


# Kichoff program summary DAY2 :Shaping Ideas

We brushed up on ideas through Day2 program.

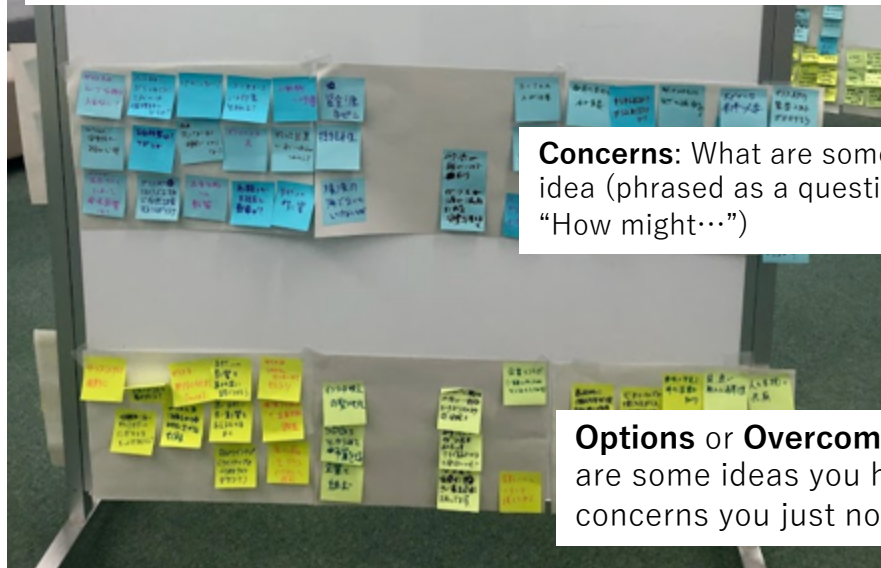
We use PPCO Workshop for reviewing each ideas with a different perspective.
