STATEMENT OF ACTIVITIES

The Chief Joe Mathias British Columbia Aboriginal Scholarship Fund (the "Fund") is a nationally registered charity established in memory of the late Chief Joe Mathias to support Chief Mathias' vision of post-secondary education for all First Nations people. The Fund is an incorporated society under the BC *Societies Act*.

The purpose of the Fund is to advance education by providing educational scholarships to deserving British Columbia First Nation students and who demonstrate merit and financial need in order to improve access to post-secondary education so that deserving British Columbia First Nation people can acquire the knowledge and skills needed to participate in a changing economy and society.

The goal of the Fund's BC First Nations Teacher Scholarship Program, established with the financial assistance of the Ministry of Education and Child Care, is to provide scholarships for First Nations students in teacher education programs offered by public post-secondary institutions in British Columbia that **lead to a Certificate of Qualification to teach in K-12 schools**. All eligible applicants will be considered for up to a \$5,000 annual scholarship.

ELIGIBLITY REQUIREMENTS

The Fund will grant scholarships only to people who:

- Are members or citizens of a British Columbia First Nation;
- Have been accepted or are enrolled in a teacher education program at one of the following public post-secondary institutions as a full-time, or part-time, student:

- 1. Simon Fraser University
- 2. Thompson Rivers University
- 3. University of British Columbia
- 4. University of British Columbia Okanagan
- 5. University of Northern British Columbia
- 6. University of the Fraser Valley
- 7. University of Victoria
- Vancouver Island University
- All teacher education programs leading to a Certificate of Qualification offered by the above institutions are eligible, including: (a) Bachelor of Education degrees; or (b) a post-degree professional/post-baccalaureate teacher education programs (i.e., where a student has already completed a bachelor's degree in another subject)..

Note that Early Childhood Education and Education Assistant programs are not eligible for this scholarship. Students in these programs may apply under the original Chief Joe Mathias Scholarship Application that is more broad-based.

APPLICATIONS

Applications will be reviewed each year at a special meeting of the Board held for the purpose of awarding Scholarships. Scholarship Applications must conform with all requirements of the following application form. Should you have any questions please email chiefjoemathias@gmail.com.

	 Part I of the Scholarship Application Form; Part II of the Scholarship Application Form for Undergraduate Students; Resume or Curriculum Vitae; One (1) letter of reference from a teacher, academic supervisor, or current/former employer; A copy of your valid status card or proof of First Nations citizenship; Proof of enrollment: A letter from the post-secondary educational institution verifying your enrollment OR a copy of your current class registration form; and A transcript of your grades including your most recent period of study.
