2024 CRA RULE CHANGES (see yellow highlighted)

OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS

The Executive Board (Officers) of this Association shall be as follows: President, Vice-President, Secretary/Call-in Secretary, Treasurer, and a Board of Directors, consisting of one (1) Director from each of the following events: Rough Stock (one Director for all rough stock), Calf Roping, Steer Wrestling, Barrel Racing, Team Roping (one [1] director), Breakaway Roping, Public Relations, and a Contract Act Director.

PERMITS

- 1. Non-member contestants may enter a CRA rodeo with the purchase of a permit. Permits are TWENTY AND NO/100 (\$20.00) DOLLARS, per rodeo. Each permit, waiver, and minor's release is good for one (1) rodeo only.
- 2. To enter on a permit, a current CRA card holder must enter the person and be responsible for any stock charge and fine imposed if the permit entry does not show up. Upon entering, a waiver of liability must be signed by the contestant. If the contestant is under 18 years of age, then a parent/legal guardian must provide a state issued ID on the waiver form and allow the pictured ID to be viewed by the rodeo secretary (no exceptions).

RODEO ENTRY RULES

To enter each rodeo, contestants may Call-in (985-860-7670) on the designated Call-in night, which is usually the Monday (6:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m.) before each rodeo or opt to use online entry when available, usually Monday before each rodeo (8:00 a.m - 8:00 p.m.).

RANCH STYLE BRONC RIDING

- 6. Any style of spurs can be used as long as rowels are dull (at least 5-point rowels) and are not locked.
- 7. Only Ranch saddles will be allowed.

CHUTE DOGGING

- 17. In any situation where there is no rule to govern, the decision of the judge will be final.
- 18. There will be a thirty (30) second time limit.

TEAM ROPING - LEGAL CATCHES

- 1. Steer must be on all four (4) feet when roped from either end. There will be only three (3) legal catches:
 - a. Head or both horns
 - b. Half a head
 - c. Around the neck
- 2. Any heel catch behind both shoulders is legal if rope goes up heels.
- Header must rope steer, dally, and change direction of steer before heeler throws his rope. Heeler cannot throw his rope before the initial switch is made. Failure (cross-firing) will result in disqualification of the team.
- 4. One hind foot receives five (5) second penalty
- 5. If loop crosses itself in a head catch, it is illegal
- 6. Dew claw catches are legal if catch holds until flag is dropped
