



RULES – SFAA Winter League

The Winter League will start in October 2020 and run for 4 months until the end of January 2021.

Please could you return the entry form with your details as soon as possible. See below link:

Quick Summary

- Any 20-yard range (10 yards for cubs): indoor, outdoor, or field may be used, provided it is safe.
- An IFAA Indoor face must be used (single or 5 spot).
- This year it is a full indoor round of 12 ends of 5 arrows.
- The best 3 scores from each of the 4 months will be totalled and used for final standings.
- The round can be shot multiple times during a month. However, the score is final when it has been submitted to the League Organiser.
- Scores should be submitted by taking a photo and emailing it to shoot_organiser@palaceriggfieldarchers.co.uk by the end of the month.
- Use the subject line Winter League – Scores. Please include your name, score, and bow style in the body of the email.
- Due to current circumstances a club official may not be required. Contact League Organiser if alternate arrangements are required.
- It is permitted to shoot a second bow style.
- Any photos of the competition are welcome.

RULES

1) WIFAC Rules of Shooting will apply.

2) The Standard IFAA Indoor Face will be shot for all styles of bows.

12 ends of 5 arrows at 20 yds (10 Yards for Cubs) with scoring being 5, 4, 3, 2,1, miss, shall be shot.

X Count should be done in the event of a tie.

2 ends for sighting may be shot. This shall be done in one sitting.

Archers can elect to use a 5 Spot Face.

3) The score for the archer's best 3 months will be compared to that of the others in the category and the winner will be decided by the highest cumulative total.



4) If an archer fails to shoot a match, they must still return their score sheet marked “not shot”.

If an archer intends to withdraw please inform the League Organiser as soon as possible to avoid unnecessary delay in issuing the results to other clubs.

5) Matches may be shot at any time during the month. A nominated Club Official will be required to check the score & to sign at the bottom of each score sheet to this effect.

6) Scores are to be recorded on official score cards and scores must be signed by each archer and witnessed by the same official as in Rule 5. All score sheets must be double checked and signed by a Club Official to eliminate mistakes and any alterations must also be signed by that same Official in red. All score sheets should be kept by the Club Official for 6 weeks after the end of the tournament so that if there is a dispute the original score sheets can be produced upon request. Failure to produce the original score sheets will automatically forfeit the dispute.

7) Completed score cards must be received by the League Organiser by the end of the month. These will be sent by email. Under no circumstances whatsoever will results be accepted if they arrive after the last day of the month for that match period. If for some reason you are late shooting your match, then you can email your results through to the League Organiser and send confirmation on the usual results sheets as soon as possible.

8) Emailed result sheets must be signed off by the designated club official.

9) Matches may be shot indoors, or outdoors if no indoor facilities are available.

10) The League Organiser will rule in the event of a dispute.
