

### SCUBA DIVING IN BORA BORA

Discover the wonders of the underwater world of Bora Bora in a comfortable boat built especially for scuba diving. Several dive sites are worth a visit, such as the protected site of Anau, which is open only in the morning. This is unique with a beautiful coral garden and slope covered with sea roses visible at the beginning of the dive. The highlight of this underwater excursion is to see the manta rays that come to this area to feed and be cleaned by small wrasses. Other dive site not to be missed: Muri-Muri or White Valley, a drift dive where it is not unusual to see grey sharks, and schools of trevally, as well as turtles and giant barracudas! Thrills guaranteed! Finally, Motu Tapu is one of the most famous dive sites in Bora Bora where lemon sharks and black tip sharks make their home.

Throughout the dives, you will be supervised by instructors certified by a luxurious PADI 5-star center that provides the latest Aqualung equipment.

Moorea definitely deserves to be explored. The island is as interested on the mountain side than on the lagoon side. It is a pleasure for all the senses. With its crater, pineapple fields, lush vegetation etc it is the perfect island for hiking, ATV or exploring on a four-wheeler. And the lagoon side offers great views on the high, sharp mountains and with his marine life is one of the nicest paradises for snorkelers and divers.

### RANGIROA

Some of the most impressive dives can be done in the 2 largest passes.

The villages of Avatoru and Tiputa sprawl lazily around their respective churches and harbors. Their passes make perfect spots for spectacular drift dives, especially the encounters with the everpresent sharks. Every dive is unique and has different surprises to offer, among them: Grey Reef sharks, Sea turtles, Humphead Wrasse, shoals of Barracudas, Manta Rays, Hammerhead sharks ..without forgetting the large and friendly dolphins that sometimes come to play!

Kia Ora Resort & SPA, the most beautiful hotel in Rangiroa, is located near Tiputa Pass and bordered by a white sand beach and a turquoise lagoon, in the heart of a magnificent coconut plantation. The 4\* hotel boasts an elegant and refined architecture in perfect harmony with its environment.

For a crescendo experience, it would have been better to start with this 4\* hotel, but as diving is a little more complicated in Rangiroa, we suggest him to dive in Moorea and Bora Bora first.

### **BORA BORA**

The South Seas legend, deserves its reputation. Almost indescribable, the color of the water scintillates with the brightest shades of blue, from cyan to turquoise, passing through emerald green to dark sapphire... The delightful illusion is created by the interplay of light, water and the brilliant white-sand, which carpets the depths of the lagoon.

The marine life in Bora Bora is equally exceptional. Take your pick: snorkel in the coral gardens, swim with sharks in the lagoon or dive on the reef front, see Pink Whipray... and maybe Manta rays, on the island's east coast, near the motu Tapu.

Conrad Bora Bora Nui is a blissful and luxurious resort where relaxation and unparalleled views await you. It is built on a hilled motu (islet) with a tropical vegetation that contrasts with the multi shades of turquoise waters of the lagoon. A real pleasure for the eyes! On top of the hill stands the Hina Spa, offering breathtaking views over the lagoon and mount Otemanu on one side and infinity views over the ocean and the neighboring islands on the other side. There are different dining options on the resort with very refine food made by Michelin awarded Chefs!

The Overwater Villa are huge (116 sqm), very elegant and comfortable. They have catamaran nets on the deck where guests may appreciate to lie down and feel like they are weightlessness on top of the lagoon.

This is our favorite luxury resort in Bora Bora! For an incredible experience, I suggest an Overwater Villa with its private pool, but other categories can be proposed.



# DISCOVER BORA BORA BY ATV (Half day)



Take a closer look at Polynesia's most famous island on an ATV expedition... Keep your eyes opened and prepare for the journey as nothing that will be seen from these mountains must be missed.

This discovery is quite an adventurous and fun one! Driving along the coast of the island, enjoy the scenery and see the locals in their natural setting: at home, in their yard, or on the side of the road waving at everyone passing by! Then, making your way to the top of Mount Popoti, a rush of adrenaline will flow your body while driving on a steep and (very) rocky road... But at the end of the road will be your pot of gold: breathtaking panoramic views of Bora Bora, Tupai, and Maupiti. The tour ends at your host's private home with a fresh fruits tasting and a demonstration of local handmade «pareu» in a beautiful garden. You may rest a little in the shade of the many trees or visit the family marae on the property. In 2.5 hours, the tour will have covered all the road framing the island built by the Americans during WWII as well as the back roads to reach the most amazing panoramic sites of the island.

The surprising colors of the vegetation and impressive Mount Otemanu, the highest point on the island, contribute to making this experience unique.

As the magic unfolds, it will be clear that the beauty of the island lies beyond its lagoon and what the eye can see.



Scuba Diving Sites in Bora Bora:

### Motu Tapu:

From the coral drop-off, you will meet lemon sharks, black tipsharks, humphead maori wrasses, moray eels, lion fishes..

### Muri Muri the White Valley:

A dive site in the exceptional deep blue of Bora Bora's famous lagoon. Accompanied by grey sharks, you encounter a sand bank inhabited by a colony of gardener and largemorays leading to a coral plateau . In deep open water, youmay sight schools of jacks, Hellerbarracudas, a playful seaturtle, who is a regular at this site and sometimes giant barracudas. Anchor or drift dive depending on weather conditions.

### <u>Anau</u>

Well known for it to be a Manta ray site, you will follow a slopewhere rose corals grow and with luck, you'll find a mantaswoop over you. This site is well protected by the localtouroperators and dive companies. Visits to this site are prohibited in the afternoons as not to upset the fragile habitatof the manta rays









# SCUBA DIVING IN MOOREA (2h00 to Full Day)







The island of Moorea offers outstanding diving sites for its underwater marine life and magnificent coral reefs. The island has more than <u>8 diving sites</u> located primarily on its northern side between the Club Med motu and Opunohu's bay. The "*Underwater Tikis*" is reputed for the <u>four species of sharks</u> that gather at this site. Drift diving at the "*Aito*" site is an exhilarating excursion for <u>turtle lovers</u>! The *corridor of the rays* is a lagoon dive in a protected site that is perfect for beginners and those in training or refreshing their diving skills. This is where we often see <u>leopard rays</u>. The site of the *anemones* is recommended for refresher divers. During this training session you will be surrounded by the <u>sea anemones</u> populated by <u>clown fish</u>! The "*Coral Roses*" site is open to experienced divers, who will appreciate the unusual beauty of the myriad of <u>coral roses</u>, as well as the <u>lemon sharks</u> that are often seen in this area. The dive center is located a just few minutes by boat to the most beautiful sites of Moorea.

### Key information:

- Operating days: All year, everyday except the 1st of January, in the morning
- Approx. departure time: 8:00am or 10:00am in the morning and 02:00pm or 04:00pm in the afternoon
- Approx. length of the tour : 2h to 7h including 30 to 45 min underwater per dive
- 1 instructor for 5 divers maximum for SHARED DIVES (15 guests maximum per dive)
- Cancellation policy: 100% penalty for cancellation at D -15. Supplier reserves the right to cancel the tour in case of unfavorable weather conditions.
- Children policy: special rates for children of less than 12 old, on request
- Restrictions: you must wait 12 hours before <u>a domestic flight</u> and at least 24 hours before an <u>international flight</u>. Divers without NITROX certification are limited to 2 air dives per day. Inform us if a diver is more than 75 years old or less than 12 years old or if there is any disability. Pregnant women are not allowed to scuba dive.

# SCUBA DIVE CENTERS AND SITES OF MOOREA



### MOOREA DIVING SITES

Most Moorea dives have an average depth of 60 feet and are ideal for beginners. Dives are usually in the lagoon in the afternoon and outside the reef in the open ocean during the morning. Typical marine encounters include large pelagic fish, morays eels, groupers, perches, unicornfish, triggerfish, groupers and of course the regular reef sharks. French Polynesia has the best shark diving in the South Pacific. Moorea is one of the rare places where a diver can observe, study and appreciate the many facets of this marine animal. In the company of trained divermasters that have years of experience with sharks, a good number of dives will bring you into contact to observe at least 4 species of sharks – the Blacktip shark, the Whitetip sharks, Grey sharks and Lemon sharks. These species of sharks do not present any danger and appear to be more timid than otherwise. Again, as in any animal, it is best not provoked.

Here are two other major scuba diving sites in Moorea:

### Taotoï pass

A favourite spot where you see many fish travel from one side of the island to the other, passing through this area. As one of the highlights - you will enjoy the huge moray eels which are quite impressive.

### The Opunohu Canyons:

Awesome undersea topography, abundant marine fauna, black tip sharks and huge lemon sharks
