New product for mite control now available!

There is a new varroa control available called Norroa - it is essentially a birth control for varroa mites - it stops reproduction.

It currently is available from Mann Lake; Woods and Beeline will likely carry it soon. A package of two (\$22) treats one deep brood box, so 2 packages (4 pouches) would be needed to treat one

double deep box) and is effective for about 18 weeks. It's available from Mann Lake in packages of 2 (\$22) and 12 (\$114) pouches which is enough to treat 3 double deep box hives. Suggested application time would be in fall when there's no brood, or spring before buildup.
