We are located in Laurens County. Tell the dispatcher you are in Laurens County; they will help you connect with the correct location. Also, keep something handy with the address for the park. Your site number is located on your electric box. This information can save time and possibly lives.

Boats cannot be parked at your campsite. When you leave, please put your boat and trailer in the boat storage areas. There is not enough room for everyone to park boats at campsites and we cannot mow or weed eat. We will move the boats as necessary from your campsite.

DHEC regulations state that no trash is to be burned in a fire ring. As we maintain the parks, we have noticed trash in fire rings. If you are using the fire ring as a way to get rid of your trash, stop. We provide dumpsters for your trash. Your fire ring will be removed from your site if you are found in non-compliance. Fire pits are for camp fires and making smores – remember we have free fire wood for your convenience.
