Part 1. What is the form of W-9? If someone hired you as an independent contractor or if you received certain types of income, you must complete Form W-9. Form W-9 (officially "Request for Your Identification Number and Certificate of a Taxpayer") is used by a third US income tax system, which should submit an information return to the tax authority. It asks for taxpayer name, taxpayers address and identifying information. But who should fill out Form W-9? The W-9 form can only be completed by those who call the "US resident". If you are a US citizen, US employee, or self-employed in a US business, you will need to complete Form W-9 after receiving money from the guest. This form is a confirmation of your income and other secondary costs. Note "The term 'we' is not just 'people.' Correctly fill the form W-9. Step 1.
