MALLA Vice President Ardoch Report 2023 & Stewardship Committee Chair 2023 Report - Ruth Cooper

We continued this last year (2022-2023) again without a President. It has been a challenge without this important position being filled. We had a few ZOOM meetings, regarding executive concerns and Stewardship Committee.

I jointly represented MALLA (with Cathy Potts), at the North Frontenac Lakes Alliance Association (NFLAA) meetings virtually. This organization helps update the local municipality and lake associations, regarding lake stewardship and is a common voice for lake concerns in the Township. Lake short-term rentals and Septic Inspection continue to be a concern, as well as proposed developments and invasive species.

Eurasian Water Milfoil (EWM) and Phragmites are on-going invasive species concerns on our lakes. Many landowners continue to try to control EWM around their docks. We now also have a new concern of zebra mussels, that have been recently found in Malcolm Lake. Education continues to be our best defence and we will continue to seek out up-to-date best practices for controlling it as well.

As acting Stewardship Coordinator, we had three very successful phragmites-pulling sessions last summer (2022) and removed several dozen bags of "phrag" again from the shoreline areas. We obtained a *Green Shovels* grant and were able to purchase more equipment/tools for the phragmites eradication. The volunteer help from both lakes was very much appreciated! This reed overtakes and eliminates native vegetation that is vital to wildlife. With successive cutting we are seeing the stands growing smaller and smaller each year, as we drown the cut reed out and slowly eradicate it. This is a good news story!

I will continue to encourage members on Ardoch Lake to join and consider helping out on our Lake Association. I trust that it will be a more social summer, with the worst of the pandemic behind us. Please continue to talk to new lake owners and help to motivate them to become part of MALLA. With education, each MALLA member can help protect our lakes for our future lake owners!



MALLA Vice President Malcolm Report 2023 Cathy Potts

What a year of learning I had after I accepted the VP Malcolm Lake position. I was fortunate to inherit a well-developed portfolio and a box of files from the outgoing VP Brenda Martin so I need to acknowledge that first. I decided to use this year to gain an understanding of MALLA's governance, its by-laws, finances and meet some folks. I went to MALLA's July Fishing Derby and BBQ and the August Corn boil for the first time, why didn't I go sooner! Gosh, fabulous food, prizes and I met a lot of great people too. I also hope that I wowed the Boat Flotilla participants with my Canada Day dock antics. It was a great summer filled with loads of happy memories. Cottage Associations can and do influence Municipal decision making.

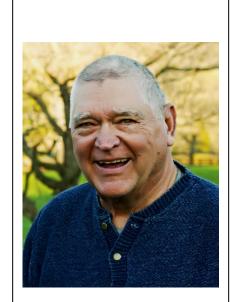
