## The Newberg Early Birds Rotary Foundation

#### Purpose

The purpose of the Newberg Early Birds Rotary Foundation (Foundation) is to promote long term improvements in the quality of life primarily focused in Newberg, OR and the surrounding areas.

#### **Funding**

The Foundation gives monetary assistance, consistent with its funding guidelines, for projects and activities that primarily support the local community and are focused on providing long term benefits. The monies for these projects and activities are raised primarily by the Newberg Early Birds Rotary Club through personal contributions. annual fund raiser(s), and from an established Endowment Fund. The Newberg Early Birds Rotary Foundation is a nonprofit organization separate from the Newberg Early Birds Rotary Club. Because the Foundation is organized under IRC Section 501(()3, all contributions are tax deductible. All fines paid by Newberg Early Birds Rotary Club members are considered contributions to the Foundation and are also deductible.

The Foundation will also provide the members of the Newberg Early Birds Rotary Club a vehicle to contribute funds that are designated for a specific project or activity, provided the project or activity is consistent with the charter of the Foundation. In order to facilitate the growth of the endowment fund, the Foundation will direct 5% of designated contributions toward the endowment fund, not to exceed \$100.

### **Application Procedures**

Requests for funding are carefully screened by the Newberg Early Birds Rotary Foundation Board of Directors and are granted on the basis of merit and consistency with the mission of the Foundation and the funding guidelines.
