Last week was "Peace Trail Village" at North Valley Friends Church with Prof. Melanie Mock and Leslie Murray.



faced some racial incidents in their Newberg High experience. Melanie was grateful for quick and decisive action by the school leadership. Still, that it happened at all, further galvanized Melanie to seek a kinder path for her community.

Part of that challenge is breaking the cycle of misinformation (ignorance) which often becomes disinformation (malice).

There are many that don't trust North Valley's motives. Is it because they're faith based?

North Valley has been practicing resource stewardship for over fifty years and needed to do something productive with the 26 acres surrounding the church property.

They sold part of the property below market value to Veritas Christian School.

They augment income by renting space to a preschool, yoga classes and weddings to name a few.



Melanie, Newberg area resident for 25 years and Professor of English at George Fox University, is author and co-author of five books including Finding yourself in a World Expecting Someone Else. She teaches First Year Writing, Journalism, Modern Novel, and more.

Leslie, Lead Pastor, has been part of NVFC pastoral team for 15 years and earned her Masters of Divinity from GFU in 2014. She drives her church to be the church and discerning what it means to be faithful in following Christ together.

Peace Trail Village is a transitional housing ministry and currently consists of a pair of tiny homes on the church property, each with toilet, shower, sink and bed.

We keep hearing of the distinction between homelessness and houselessness. "People can experience homelessness but are "sheltered.""

Every Village guest has medical needs but must be able to pull themselves back to self reliance after treatment.

Guests must pass a national criminal history check and may not have sexual or violent crimes in their history. Nor may they be in a current state of addiction.

The project will eventually expand from the current two to a total of eleven tiny homes that will be located on Providence Newberg's property. They will be 300 sq ft and set on foundations with connection to water, sewer and electricity.

BOB will provide wrap-around services, case management, referrals and benefit navigation (like Oregon Health Plan). BOB, Better Outcomes thru Bridges is a



Providence initiative available throughout Oregon.

While it is a truth that the addicted and mentally ill are the highest contributors to houselessness, it is also true that we are called to care for each other.

Peace Trail needs your voice in destigmatizing the work being done. They need positive advocates to direct questions about Peace Trail to Melanie or BOB.

Q: When is the beginning?

A: Planning has begun thanks to a grant from the City of Newberg and a tentative agreement from Water & Sewer.

Q: What is the typical stay?

A: Typical is 6-24 months. But if the guest has no income, and no path forward, they are not a right fit.

Q: Does NVFC allow car camping?

A: Though approached often, no, not right now. Previously had allowed up to two weeks but need to allay concerns of neighbors. Leslie had found a car under their carport. The mother had a 5 year old sleeping that was afraid of the dark.
