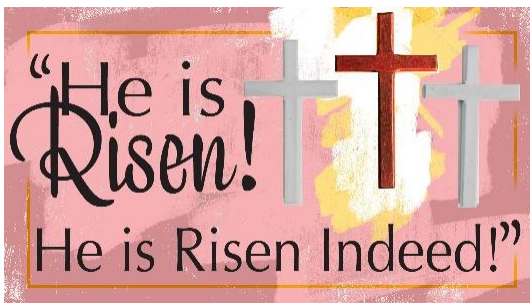

Nurturing Faith Ideas 2026, based on the Revised Common Lectionary

April 5: Resurrection of the Lord/Easter Day - Read Matthew 28:1-10

On Sunday, you may have heard and/or said, “Christ is risen. He is risen indeed.” The good news of Christ being raised from the dead is that he is alive, even today. Share with someone what Easter means to you.

April 12: Second Sunday of Easter - John 20:19-31

When the disciples told Thomas that Jesus had appeared to them, Thomas struggled to believe until he saw Jesus himself. What causes you to question or doubt? Do you think you would have responded like Thomas? Why or why not?

April 19: Third Sunday of Easter - Read Luke 24:13-25

It’s easy to remember Jesus’ words, “This is my body broken for you. Do this in remembrance of me,” when we celebrate the Lord’s Supper in worship. This week, each time you eat bread, remember those words again. With whom might you share a meal this week and experience the presence of Jesus, who loves us forever?

April 26: Fourth Sunday of Easter - Read Psalm 23

The fourth Sunday of Easter is often called “Good Shepherd Sunday.” Psalm 23 reminds us that God takes care of us as a shepherd takes care of their sheep, providing food and water, giving them time to rest, leading them in right paths, protecting them. God is our Good Shepherd; we are God’s sheep. What does it mean to think of yourself as a sheep of God?

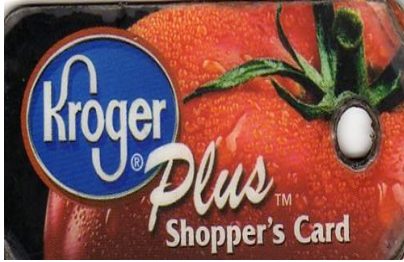
Blessing of the Backpacks

WORSHIP (W): The estimated total communicants on March 1 was 33 (20 in-person + 13 estimated online). The next communion

will be on April 5, Easter. **If you are joining worship from home that day, please remember to prepare your elements in advance.**

The purple drape on the yard cross will remain there until it will be replaced by a black drape on Good Friday morning. A white drape will replace the black one on Easter morning to celebrate Our Lord's resurrection. The Good Friday service will be at noon.

ADMINISTRATION & FINANCE (A&F): City National Bank (CNB) and RLPC signed a 60 day extension on the interest only solar panel loan payments. The general fund has about \$94,500.

CHRISTIAN NURTURE (CN):

MISSION & SERVICE (M&S): The One Great Hour of Sharing offering will conclude on Easter.

PROPERTY (P): The footbridge needs resurfacing but will wait for warmer weather to repair.

CONGREGATIONAL CARE (CC): The next potluck lunch will be April 12. The church received a thank-you letter from Nathan Argento, the 2024 Inghram Scholarship winner. Nathan is at WVU, studying for an engineering degree.




OTHER (O): a. Session approved granting a WV American Water Company right of way to permit the water company to connect water lines across the small parking area adjacent to the choir room and playground. b. Cherrie Sizemore, from the PWV Committee on Pastoral Ministry (COPM), conducted an exit interview of the session to discuss Patricia Jarvis's ministry at RLPC. The session was very positive about Patricia's service at Rock Lake, the time that the congregation had to adjust to her departure, and that the congregation had two opportunities in December to show appreciation for her ministry. Cherrie advised that a liaison would be appointed to help Rock Lake as we seek a new pastor.
