## Nurturing Faith Ideas 2026, based on the Revised Common Lectionary

### **January 4: Second Sunday of Christmas - *Read John 1:1-18***

John's gospel does not have a story of Jesus' birth. Instead, it identifies Jesus as the Word who has been active since the beginning and who began human and lived among humans showing them God's grace. Some didn't recognize him or accept him. How does your life show that you recognize Jesus? How do you reflect Jesus' gift of grace to the world?

### **January 6: Epiphany - *Read Matthew 2:1-12***

Following a star three Magi journey to Bethlehem bearing gifts fit for a king. Finding the child, they knelt and proclaimed God's praise. What gifts might you bring for the young Jesus? What might you praise God for this week?

### **January 11: Baptism of the Lord - *Read Matthew 3:13-17***

As we celebrate Jesus' baptism, we also remember our own baptism. We are baptized into the body of Christ, and we are also empowered by the same Spirit of God that descended upon Jesus. What do you remember, or have you been told about your baptism? What does your baptism mean to you? Share with someone and ask them about their baptism.

### **January 18: Second Sunday after Epiphany - *Read John 1:29-42***

This is a story about introducing others to Jesus. John pointed out Jesus to two of his disciples, and they followed Jesus to where he was staying. One of them, Andrew found his brother, Simon Peter," and brought him to Jesus, the Messiah. Who have you told Jesus about? What did you tell them?

### **January 25: Third Sunday after Epiphany - *Read Matthew 4:12-23***

This is Matthew's story of Jesus calling his first disciples, somewhat different from John's story last week. Here, Jesus invites Peter, Andrew, James, and John to follow him and do something different – fish for people. They left behind their boats and their work, the way of life they were used to, and followed him. What makes your life different as you follow Jesus?


## CENTS-ABILITY OFFERING

The church decorations will be put away after worship on January 4. The next committee meeting is 3pm January 21.

We hope you will make in-person worship a priority at the start of each week.

**ADMINISTRATION & FINANCE (A&F):** David reported that the general account has about \$83,000 in it. Budget vs. actual November income was about \$10,000, with a positive month balance of about \$2,100. The November YTD balance is positive \$19,000. An A&F meeting is set for 10am December 29 to complete the church financial audit.

The clerk brought two motions which had been discussed in the A&F; but not heretofore brought to session:

**Motion 1:** 'Allow the A&F committee to update the Rock Lake Presbyterian Church, Pearl S. Inghram Memorial Scholarship Grant to the new name Rock Lake Presbyterian Church Incorporated, Pearl S. Inghram Memorial Grant.' John Solberg seconded the motion. If approved, A&F will send a letter of instruction, a copy of the minutes addressing this change, proof of name change, and new signers to be designated. The motion was approved with a unanimous "Amen!"

**Motion 2:** 'Allow the A&F committee to send an application to New Covenant Funds opening an account Rock Lake Presbyterian Church Incorporated Memorial Fund Balanced Growth Fund making it an interest-bearing account.' David Broyles seconded. If approved, it will include 1.) the current Memorial Fund account at Chase (\$4,286.75 is earmarked for the "Saints Who've Gone Before") for the LED sign on the corner. Note: there are two items still to come from that money: a. \$1,000 to John Solberg to fix the electric connection to the LED sign and b. funds for the landscaping around the sign. 2.) \$6,000 donated in memory of John and Betty Oakes (undesignated). 3.) \$2,180 donated in memory of Dick and Jo Clark (designated for youth program) currently in the New Property account. The total of these three items is \$12,466.75. This motion was also approved unanimously with session's "Amen!"

The current 2026 commitments are \$108,680. Follow-up snailmail letters will be sent in early January.

The nominating committee has filled the class of 2028 slate of two session nominees and one nominating committee nominee.

#### **CHRISTIAN NURTURE (CN):**

**MISSION & SERVICE (M&S):** The chair reviewed the visitation schedule for the Oakwood Terrace gift giving on December 21. Ed Bailey was the RLPC Santa at 3pm at apartment 950 on the estate. Families are scheduled to visit him at specific times. Help is still needed to get the gifts to the estate, and help with the family visits. The Christmas Joy offering ended December 21. Shepherd's Run cookie boxes were assembled after worship December 21 for delivery on Christmas Eve.

**PROPERTY (P):** After the December 14 service was canceled, John cleared the parking lot enough for Sandy to park and walk across the bridge Monday morning.

**CONGREGATIONAL CARE (CC):** The next second Sunday potluck will be January 11.

**OTHER: a.** In 2026, Taylor Bailey will replace Mary Wagner as treasurer. Thank you, Mary, for your many years of dedication to this work!

**b.** Pollen8 has asked RLPC to furnish a lease proposal for the next 5 years of Appalachian Behavioral Health Care (ABHC) operation. The Administration & Finance Committee has submitted that proposal, increasing the monthly lease payment from \$1,000 to about \$1,300. The A&F approved a minor change proposed by Pollen8, and signing is expected soon.

**c.** The ABHC has asked permission to erect a sign on the RLCLC property; the main building is the preferred location. Session approved the following motion: 'That after a new lease is signed, Appalachian Behavioral Health Care (ABHC) be permitted to **a.** carefully remove the building *ROCK LAKE COMMUNITY LIFE CENTER* sign letters, package and return them to the church. **b.** erect a church-approved ABHC sign on the building. The tall parking lot RLCLC sign post will not be affected.'


