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**Nurturing Faith Ideas 2026, based on the Revised Common Lectionary**

**February 1: Fourth Sunday after Epiphany - Read Matthew 5:1-12**

Jesus was a teacher. Throughout his life, he taught his disciples, and those in the crowds that gathered around them, about God and God's ways. Here he speaks a word of hope to those in 2 difficult circumstances as he teaches about how God's ways and will are different from how we as human beings think. Who is a teacher who has helped you understand more about God?

**February 8: Fifth Sunday after Epiphany - Read Matthew 5:13-2**

Jesus tells his disciples they are the salt of the earth and the light of the world. Salt changes things, particularly how they taste and are preserved, and light brightens things around us up, taking away some of the scariness. How, as a follower of Jesus, are you changing things around you for the good and making things less scary?



**February 15: Transfiguration of the Lord - Read Matthew 17:1-9**

Here we find the story of Jesus’ transfiguration while he was on the mountaintop with the disciples Peter, James, and John. There they heard a voice from heaven say, “This is my beloved Son; listen to him.” How do you think the disciples felt when they heard the voice? How would you have felt? How do you listen to Jesus today?

**February 22: First Sunday in Lent - Read Matthew 4:1-11**

After he was baptized, Jesus was led by the Spirit into the wilderness where he was tempted by the devil. It was a time for reflection and preparation as Jesus got ready to go about his work as God’s Son on earth. The devil encouraged him to take care of his own needs, test God’s faithfulness, and rule the world, if he would only follow the devil. Instead, Jesus chooses to follow God and do what God wanted. How have you been tempted to not follow God and God’s way? What happened?

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**MEET REV. KATHRYN W. WEED**  
New Moderator of Session

A native of Georgia, Rev. Kathryn Willoughby Weed moved to West Virginia in 1995 after stops in California, North Carolina, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania. 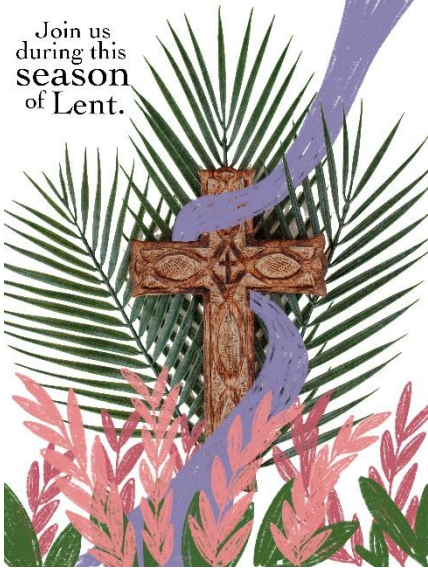

The liturgical color for Lent is purple, symbolizing the royalty of Christ.

You are invited to join us at noon on Ash Wednesday, February 18, when Rev. Kathryn Willoughby Weed will lead worship. The service will include the imposition of ashes, the physical sign of our mortality and of our belonging to Christ. This worship will not be live-streamed.

## CENTS-ABILITY OFFERING

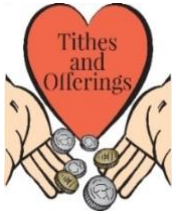


From the PCUSA website:

**ADMINISTRATION & FINANCE (A&F):** Session approved the 2026 budget as presented in the Annual Congregational Meeting packet.

For 2025, the church finished the year with about \$22,500 surplus. Finally the committee completed auditing the church books on December 29.

The nominating committee has filled the class of 2028 slate of two session nominees and one nominating committee nominee.

With responses from follow-up stewardship letters, the 2026 stewardship commitments total \$112,080. Thank you all for your generous support!
