Nurturing Moments

Please use these suggested scriptures, questions, and activities to help you explore your faith.

September 6: Read Psalm 119:33-40 This is part of the longest chapter of all the Bible! It celebrates God's Law. Each section contains eight lines beginning with the same Hebrew letter. Write brief prayers for each member of your family that begin with the first letter of their first name.

September 13: Read Matthew 18:21-22 In Matthew 18: 21-22, Jesus says we are to forgive 70 x 7 times – that's 490 times! Find something you have a lot of – pennies, dried beans, grains of rice, Legos. Count out 490 of them. Was that hard? Do you think Jesus just wants us to keep track or to always be forgiving?

September 20: Read Psalm 145:1-8 Psalm 145: 1-8 says, "Generation after generation stands in awe of your work; each one tells stories of your mighty acts" (The Message). Ask someone of an older generation to share a story with you of a time when God helped them, or share your stories together.

September 27: Read Psalm 25:1-9 Psalm 25:5 says, "Take me by the hand; lead me down the path of truth" (The Message). Take a walk down a path, and think/talk about places where you could get lost if you left the path. What does it mean for God to take you by the hand and lead you down the path of truth?

If you are contacted by church staff or session, please take time to confirm your contact info. Graduation gifts have been awarded to two graduating seniors in July worship services. Congratulations to Layne Gumowski and Lauren Taylor!

PROPERTY: The sanctuary air conditioning needs repair or possible replacement. Thanks to Eric Hamilton for his hard work on the sanctuary A/V project! The committee is seeking a gutter contractor to make repairs at the church. A number of rainstorms over the last 5 weeks, which were expected to put water in the pre-school basement, did not result in a flooded basement. Additionally, the breezeway sump pump has not even been activated. We are checking with the city to see if recent work on their storm water system may be responsible.

At a recent meeting at the CLC of RLPC, City of South Charleston (Steve Debarr), Brewer & Company of WV, Inc., and Pollen8, a flood issue will be solved as a result of Steve's agreement to install and maintain a lift station on the property. Also, the excavator will be removed one way or another in the next several weeks. The city will remove the apartment demolition rubble on Lincoln Drive. CLC building renovation plans have been submitted to the city; a tentative city approval is subject to the Fire Marshal's support.



Informal discussion has been ongoing with First Presbyterian Church, South Charleston (FPCSC) about the possibility of RLPC sharing a pastorate with that congregation. HURRICANE LAURA

Presbyterian Disaster Assistance enables congregations and mission partners of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A) to witness to the healing love of Christ through caring for communities adversely affected by crisis and catastrophic event.

The Presbyterian Disaster Assistance Fund provides support and help in the wake of

Hurricane Laura. Hurricane Laura, the strong category 4 storm, made landfall in the early hours of August 27th on the coast of Louisiana, about 30 miles from the Texas border, bringing lashing rain and sustained winds of 130 miles per hour. Many people are without electricity and other sustainable goods. While the storm was downgraded to a category 2 as it moved further inland, hurricane-force winds and widespread damage continues. PDA is also working with our international partners where Hurricane Laura impacted Haiti and the Dominican Republic, in addition to the affected U.S. presbyteries. This is addition to the pandemic.
