BLESSING OF THE ANIMALS

On Saturday, October 7, at 11:00, Rock Lake Presbyterian Church will offer our first-ever Blessing of the Animals. We hope members of the community will attend, as well as our own church family. If the weather cooperates, we gather on the back lawn, but if it rains, we will move under the breezeway.

The first weekend in October is a traditional time to hold such an event, and for many years it has been a part of many congregation's calendars. This weekend is near the birthday of St. Francis, the patron saint of the environment and animals. He was born in 1181 in Italy, and although he was born into a wealthy family, he renounced wealth and privilege and spent his life as a monk. There are many stories about Francis and his relationship to animals.

Revelation 5:13 says "Then I heard every creature in heaven and on earth, and under the earth, and in the sea, and all that is in them, singing: 'To the one seated on the throne and to the Lamb, be blessing and honor and glory and might forever and ever.'"

Note that it's not just the people, but all creation that is part of that heavenly scene! Those of us who are blessed to have loved an animal know that a beloved pet can reflect the nature of God - the unconditional love, the endless forgiveness.

So, we bring our pets to be blessed, remembering with gratitude that they, and all the creation, are gifts from our gracious and loving God.



People from four local churches {Bream, Kanawha United, First Presby (Charleston), and Rock Lake} are meeting to prepare for purchasing gifts for kids of residents in the Oakwood Terrace Apartments.

Rock Lake has committed to purchasing and wrapping gifts for about 25 kids there. Like the other churches, RLPC is expected to have gifts wrapped and delivered to a central sorting location, yet to be determined, by Friday afternoon, December 8.

Sorting and grouping of gifts by apartment, with devotional items and candy, will happen Friday evening through Sunday evening, December 10. Last minute revisions and corrections to apartment bags will be done by Friday evening, December 15.

Churches will pick up assigned routes for apartment bag delivery by 12 noon Saturday, December 16. Churches will deliver apartment bags to residents on their assigned routes starting at 2:00 pm, Sunday, December 17.

The project team is currently developing the kids' age groupings for whom each church will be purchasing and wrapping gifts. When we have those details for RLPC, we will reach out for your help. Please respond when we do!
