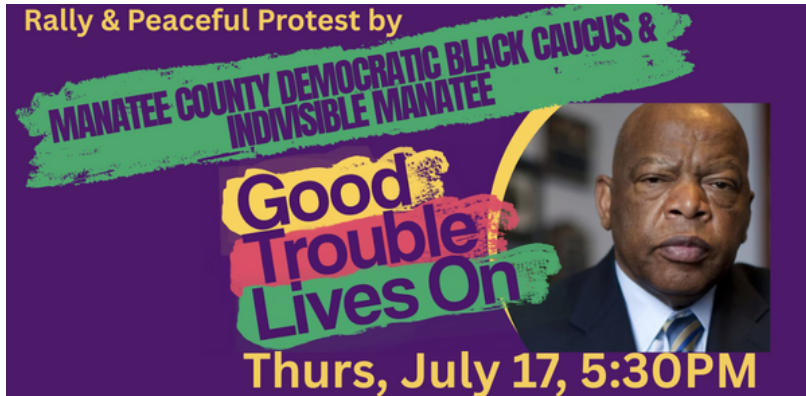

It doesn't have to be this way. Trump is trying to divide us, but we know the power of coming together. Unity Is Our Victory.

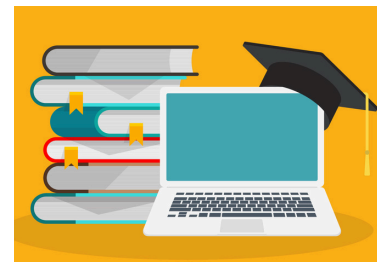

FDP Alligator Alcatraz Update

Florida Democratic Lawmakers were denied entry to 'Alligator Alcatraz' due to "safety concerns." If it's unsafe for lawmakers to visit, how is it safe for anyone inside?

- Florida lawmakers, Rep Anna Eskamani, Rep Carlos Guillermo Smith, Rep. Angie Nixon, and Rep. Michele Rayner were blocked from entering a state-funded detention site because of so-called 'safety concerns'. This is a taxpayer-funded facility, run by the State of Florida.
- Our elected officials have every legal right to walk through those gates. What are Ron DeSantis and his administration trying to hide?

If you voted by mail in the last election - it's time to renew.

If you haven't requested a mail ballot before - do it today. It is the best way to make certain your vote is counted. The Manatee Supervisor of Elections offers VoteTrax a system that allows you to confirm the receipt and processing of your ballot.

Florida voters need to make a new request, every two years, for a VBM ballot following each General Election. It is a safe and easy process. You'll need your name, date of birth and either the last 4 of your social or your FL issued DL or ID number.

Faces may change but our fight for democracy remains the same.

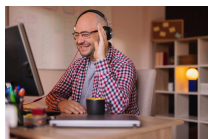
