Want to know how to advocate for issues important to you and help Democrats win in the 2026 midterm elections? Dem Expo 2025 will feature action-oriented breakout sessions on topics that are vital for success in upcoming elections. In addition, there will be opportunities to interact with social and activist clubs and caucuses and chat with MCDP leaders.

Topics for the breakout sessions include social media techniques; registering new voters; enrolling voters in the Vote-By-Mail program; information about phoning, texting and emailing potential voters; and what is required to be a candidate for local elected offices.

The purpose of Dem Expo 2025 is to attract volunteers and help local Democrats turn Manatee blue. From clubs and caucuses to committees to phone callers, there are positions in the organization for everyone who is concerned about the Republican dominance of our local, state and national politics. Demonstrate at Rep. Buchanan's Office

Republicans recently sent a budget bill to the House floor that would further escalate their war on the middle class. Every Republican voted for it. For the budget to pass into law, the House and Senate must agree on a single budget resolution.

The bill contains cuts to social safety net programs, including Medicaid and SNAP. These programs subsidize healthcare and food for people who cannot afford it. To protest the actions of Republican lawmakers, Indivisible Manatee is staging demonstrations every other Thursday at Congressman Vern Buchanan's Lakewood Ranch office. The next demonstration is March 20 from 9 to 10 a.m.
