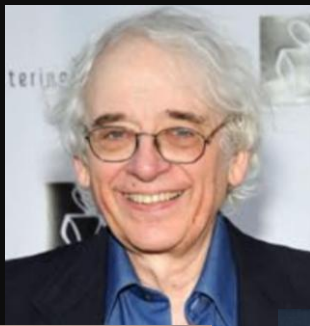
**Amanda McBain:** The disruptor. Kurt's ex-wife.

**BANKS:** Billionaire. Republican. Could he be a contender in the bluest city in the land?

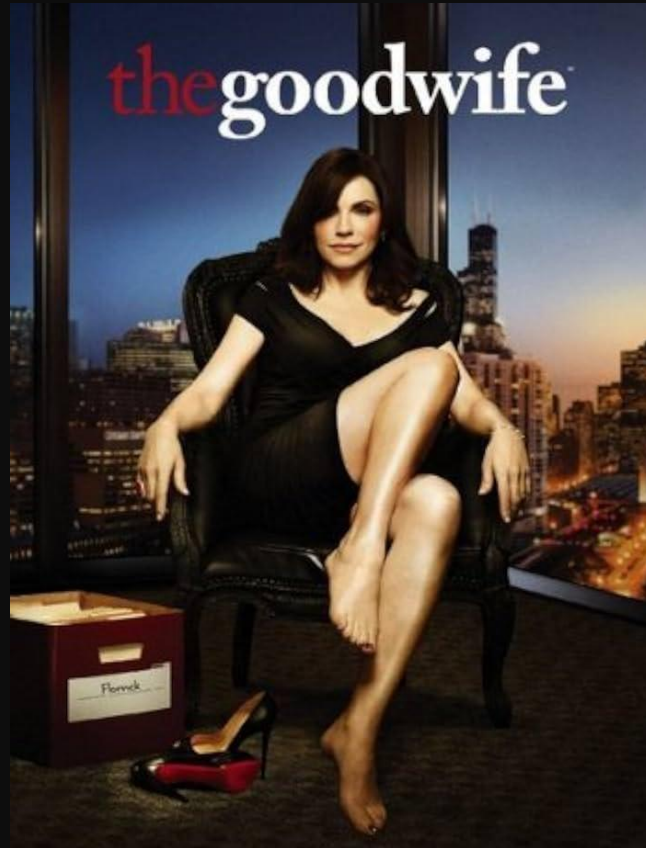
**REEVES:** Banks' fixer. Kurt's college friend.

# FUNDING & ROI

- ↓ Caffeine & Dreams is a New York based Limited Liability Company and its managers bring 40 years of experience in the entertainment and news media industry. The company was formed to produce the episodic series and gain distribution of the project through domestic broadcast and/or streaming distribution and/or any ad share revenue.
- ↓ The company is currently following a multi-track model, seeking a combination of private equity investment, production tax-credits and production deferment, as well as an equity advanced against partial distribution rights.
- ↓ Investors will be 'B-Class Members' within the production company. As early-stage investors, an additional one-time (not per annum) interest on investment of 10% will be paid out of first monies, immediately after deferment. Crew deferment will be capped upon budget finalization and allocated only to key production crew to offset any reduction in related crew or professional fees. Investors will share in the long-term distribution sales revenue
