Stop 2: Private Tour of Historic Camp Naco

Join us for a **very special private tour** of **Camp Naco**, one of the most important cornerstones of Buffalo Soldier history. This nationally significant, 100-year-old adobe military camp sits just **600 yards north of the U.S.–Mexico border**.

In **May 2022**, Camp Naco was named one of **America's 11 Most Endangered Historic Places** by the **National Trust for Historic Preservation**.

Several knowledgeable guides will be on site to lead tours of the grounds. Construction and renovations are in progress. Please wear appropriate footwear.

- Approx. **45 min** from Fort Huachuca
- Approx. **1 hr 46 min scenic drive** from Nogales
