When 'Broadway Joe' beat the Colts the whole world took notice – at least that's the way I saw it. And then I loved the Dolphins and Don Shula and Mercury Morris and Larry Csonka. Of course I loved the Dallas Cowboys, Tom Landry and Roger Staubach. And the Chicago Bears and the Los Angeles Rams and the Pittsburgh Steelers.

I was in the back seat of my parent's car listening to the radio in 1972 when Franco Harris made the 'Immaculate Reception' that gave the Steelers the victory over the Raiders in the AFC Championship game (if you look that up, the Steelers were trailing, 7-6, with 22 seconds left. Terry Bradshaw threw a pass that bounced off the helmet of the Raiders' Jack Tatum, and into the hands of Franco Harris who caught it and ran into the endzone for a TD – and the Steelers won! I was in the backseat shouting, "He caught it, he caught it!").


You may say, "Well, Parker, you are a pastor now. What does football have to do with God?"

Name something unique about you that very few people know.


*I used to walk unaided, dance, run, ride a bike, bounce on a trampoline, and pick up my kids when they were little






