OFFICIAL JOINING INSTRUCTIONS FOR NEW CADETS (2026–27)

1. Welcome Note from the Principal

2. Reporting Schedule

- **Batch 1 - Classes VII, VIII, IX, O-Level:** 28–29 March
- **Classes X, XI, A-Level:** 21–22 April
- **Reporting Time:** 10:00 AM – 05:00 PM
- **Location:** Cadet College Pano Aqil Campus

Cadets must report in proper dress, with complete documentation and required kit.

3. Mandatory Documents (Compulsory)

All cadets must bring the following documents:

1. Medical Fitness Certificate (with complete lab reports)
2. School Leaving Certificate
3. Previous Academic Record / Result Card
4. Copy of B-Form / CNIC (if applicable)
5. Passport Size Photographs (6 copies)
6. Visitor Proforma (Annexure-A duly filled)
7. Undertaking by Parents regarding discipline & rules

Note: With certain documents deficient the cadets shall be allowed to start the academic session however the onus of responsibility to complete the remaining documents within next 40 days shall remain on the Parents / guardian. Admission will not be finally confirmed on completion of documentation.

5. Personal Kit (To Be Brought by Cadets)

A. Clothing & Essentials

- White Shalwar Kameez (minimum 3-6 pairs – standard pattern only)
- Vest & Underwear (White, adequate quantity)
- White Prayer Cap
- Black Peshawari Chappal
- Bathroom Slippers
- Swimming Costume, Goggles & Cap

B. Bedding

- Blanket / Quilt (Seasonal)
- White Bed Sheets (2–3)
- Pillow (Cotton)
- Foam Mattress (6 x 3 ft) (shall also be available at the Uniform Contractor shop, Contact no 03153156986)

C. Personal Use Items

- Towels (White, 2–3)
- Toiletry Kit (Soap, Toothpaste, Brush, Nail Cutter etc.)
- Shoe Polish & Brush
- Clothes Hangers (Plastic)
- Small Rechargeable Light

6. Optional (Permitted with Guidelines)

A. Laptop (Allowed)

- Permitted strictly under College SOP
- Subject to registration, inspection, and monitoring

- Misuse will result in confiscation and disciplinary action

B. Bicycle / Mountain Bike

- Allowed for recreation
- Must be registered with College Administration
- Helmet and safety compliance recommended

C. Books

- Personal books allowed (academic / moral / inspirational only)
- Strict prohibition on immoral or inappropriate material.

D. Indoor Sports Equipment (Optional)

- Table tennis rackets / balls.
- Badminton rackets
- Hockey stick and guards
- Karate Dress

7. Mobile Phone Policy (STRICTLY REGULATED)

Keypad Phone

- Allowed only on **weekends for limited duration (approx. 4 hours)**
- Must be registered with House Master

Smartphones

- **NOT allowed for routine weekend use**
- Must be deposited with College Administration at the time of joining
- Returned only during vacations / leave

Educational Use Exception

- Smartphones and Laptops may be issued temporarily during:
 - Academic sessions
 - AI / Digital Learning classes
 - Educational research work
- Strict supervision will be ensured

8. Strictly Prohibited Items

The following items are **ABSOLUTELY FORBIDDEN**:

- Cigarettes, Tobacco, Naswar, Drugs, Intoxicants
- Weapons (Knife, Cutter, Firearms, Sharp Objects)
- Unauthorized Electronic Devices
- Electric Appliances (Heaters, Kettles, etc.)
- Objectionable / Immoral Material
- Any item posing safety or disciplinary risk

Violation = Immediate Disciplinary Action and heavy fines

9. Discipline & Code of Conduct

- Follow daily routine without deviation
- Uphold Islamic and moral values
