

Hello, I am 17 year old KeyAna Williams. Earlier this year, at a routine physical, a lump was discovered in my breast. My doctor recommended I have a sonogram done as a precaution. The result of this test was a mass that was "suspicious and abnormal". I was then ordered to a specialist who advised removal of the lump for a more thorough look.

Fortunately for me, tests on the mass proved that it was benign, a relief to me and my family. Again I am 17 years old and a lump was discovered in ME, a normal, otherwise healthy teenager. I encourage everyone to give yourself routine self exams and if you discover anything that is not supposed to be there, talk to your doctor. Also, make sure a breast exam becomes part of your annual physical exam whether it is manual, sonogram or mammogram.

This is a personal part of me I am sharing because I am taking the fight against breast cancer PERSONALLY – NOW IS YOUR TURN TO JOIN THE FIGHT


