

## **2021 Spring Meeting**

Both Rich Hamilton (Secretary) and Mike Chin (President) were re-elected.

The scholarship committee of Curt Briscoe, Todd Thurston, and Marty Schmidt were also approved to continue doing the great job that they do.

The first round of the Four Ball Championship will all be held on the same day and you must play that day to play in the tournament, just like the Club Championship. Also, it was stated that this is a weekend men's club. If you're not available to play your matches on the weekend, then don't sign up. If the match is not played within the 2-week time limit, the forfeit will go to the team that was available to play on the weekend.

We are restructuring the Championship Bracket for the Club Championship. It will include the top 16 index players that have signed up. Losers in the first round will then drop down to the first flight and play out that bracket. The rest of the brackets will continue as they did before. You will no longer be able to opt in or out of the Championship Bracket. Each bracket, except the Championship bracket, will pay the same for first and second. The Championship bracket will pay a little more, since it's the biggest and hardest bracket to win.

The Dillon Auction will continue on the Thursday prior to the tournament. However, we will have a 9-hole scramble before the auction, and the teams will be made up of your Dillon teammates. It will be a fun way to get to play with your teammates prior to the tournament. And then eat, drink and bid at the auction.

There will now be a mandatory dropout fee of \$25 to any individual who drops out of a tournament after the pairings or teams have been made. That penalty will be added to the payout of the tournament.

Anyone who drops out of the Dillon once the team has been auctioned will have to pay a mandatory \$50 dropout fee to the owner of the team.

We discussed and approved removing the Baseball tournament for a 27-hole tournament. However, after the meeting, a few members and the tournament committee agreed that instead we will keep the Baseball tournament the way it is but expand the Ryder Cup tournament to 27 holes.

There was another lengthy discussion about the tee boxes and in the end, it was agreed that we will continue to all play the white tees as the entire club voted and agreed upon in 2017.
