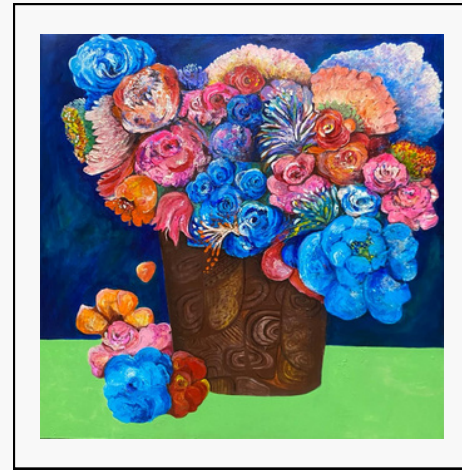

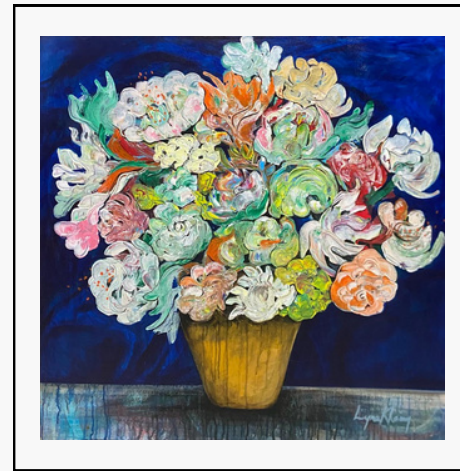

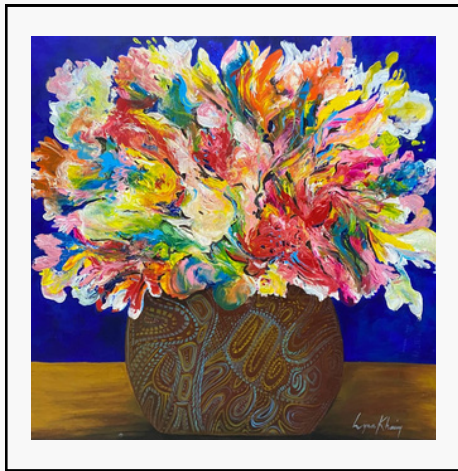

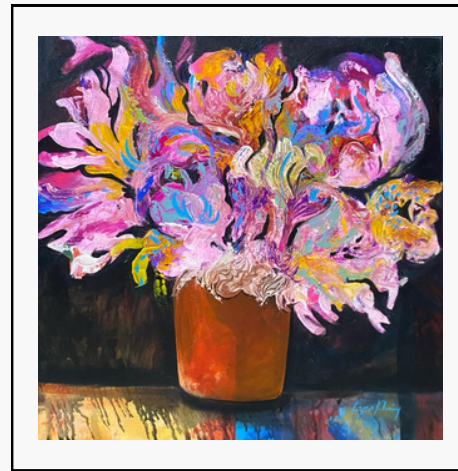

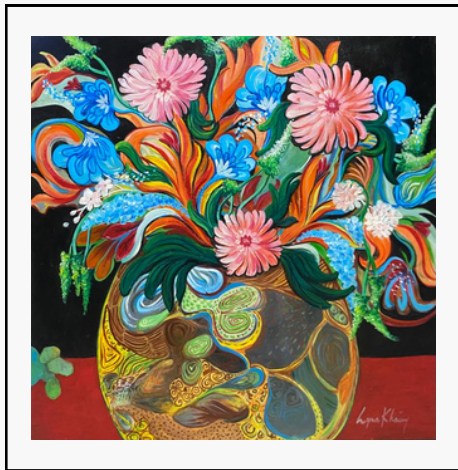
The Vase of Loves I (2024)

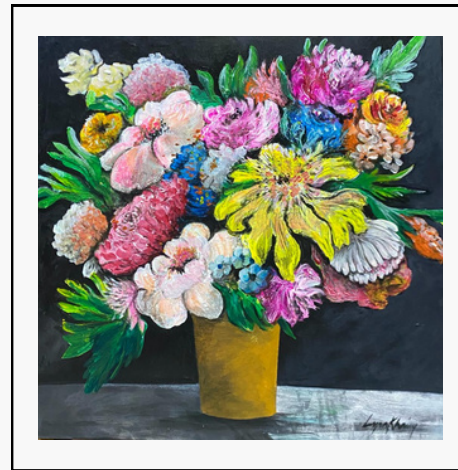

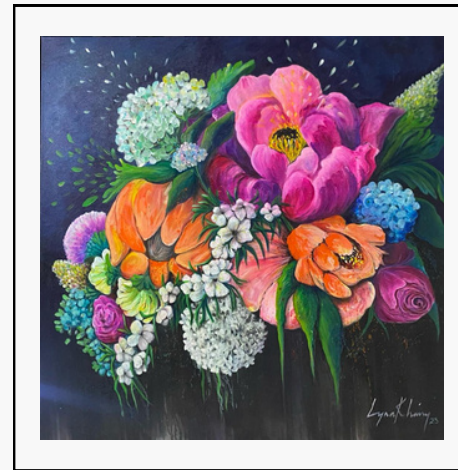

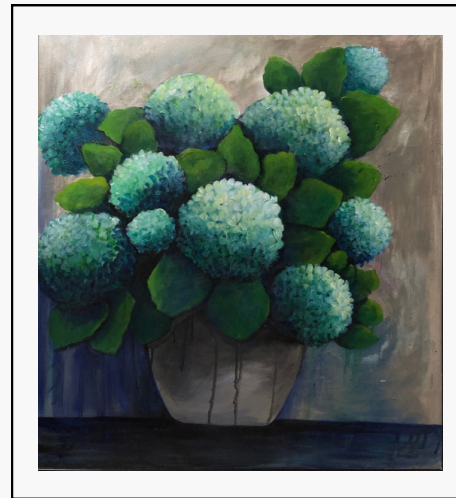
THE HYDRANGEA

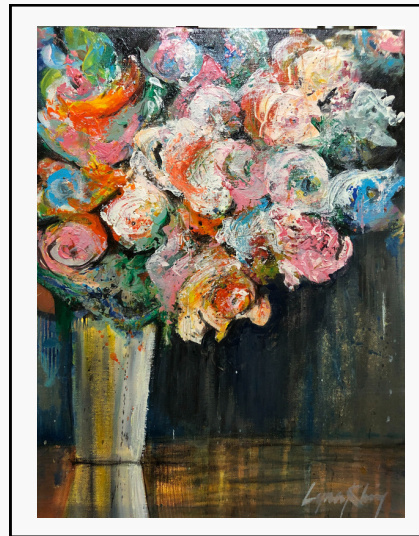

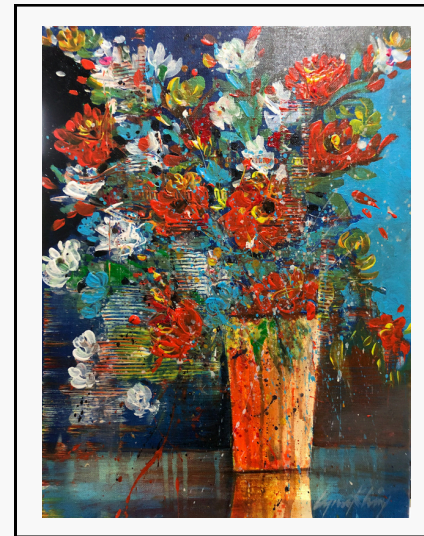

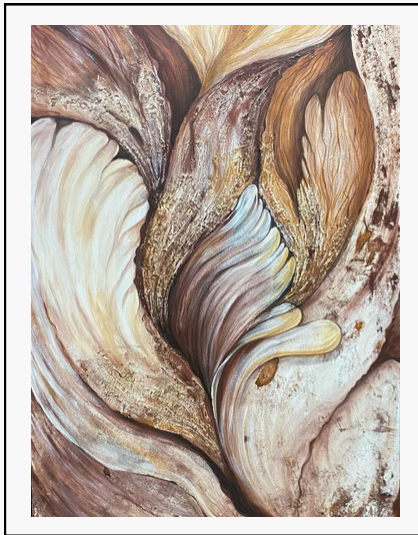
The Dancing Petals represent many different kinds of flower species in Mak's garden.

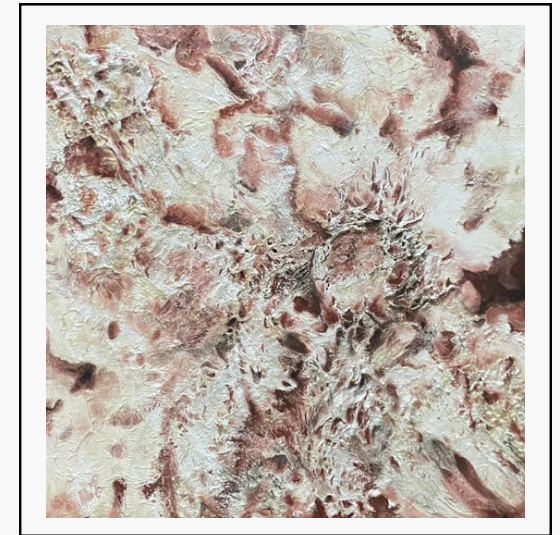

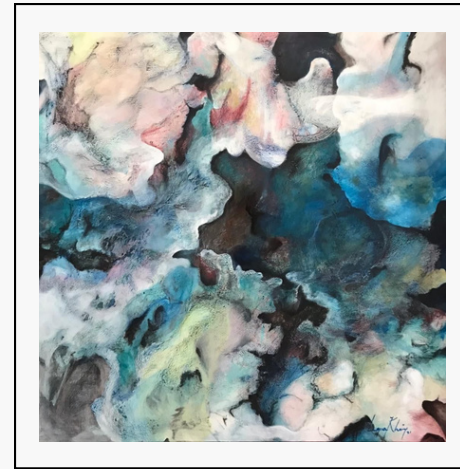

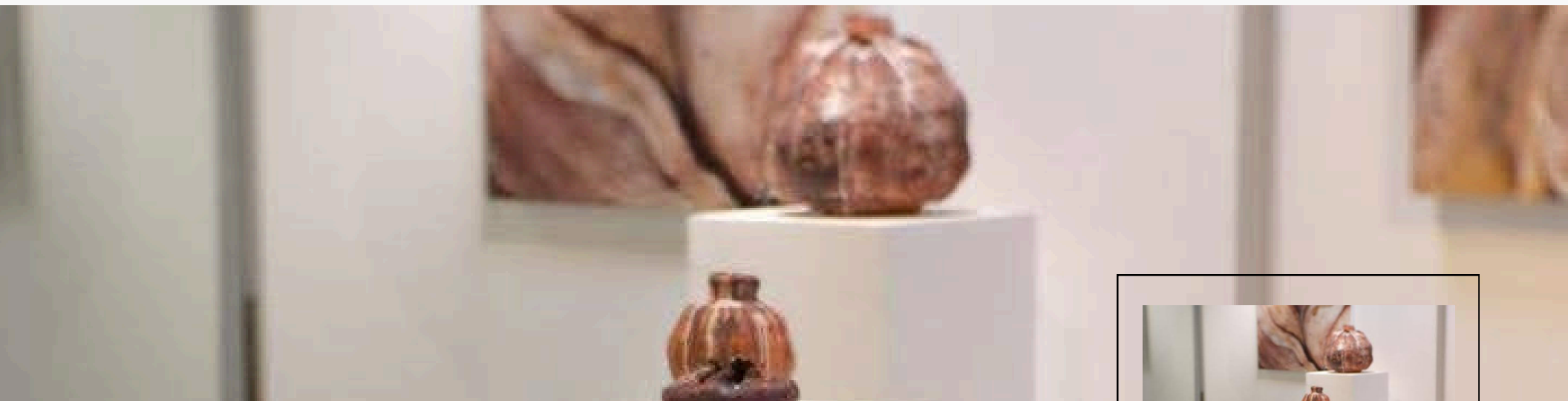
Drawn by the whispers of clay vessels adorning Mak's garden, the artist intertwined this primal essence with her masterful strokes upon her canvas creations.

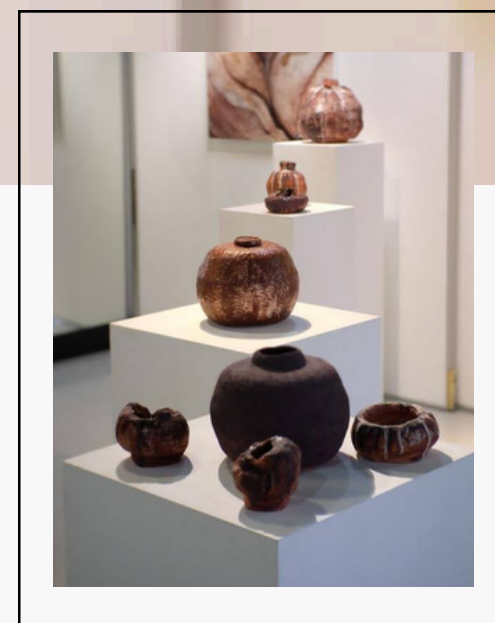

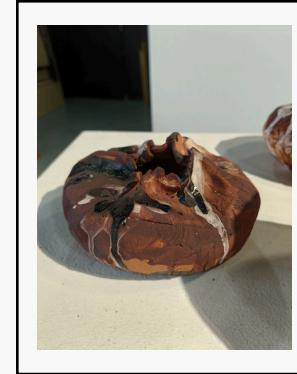

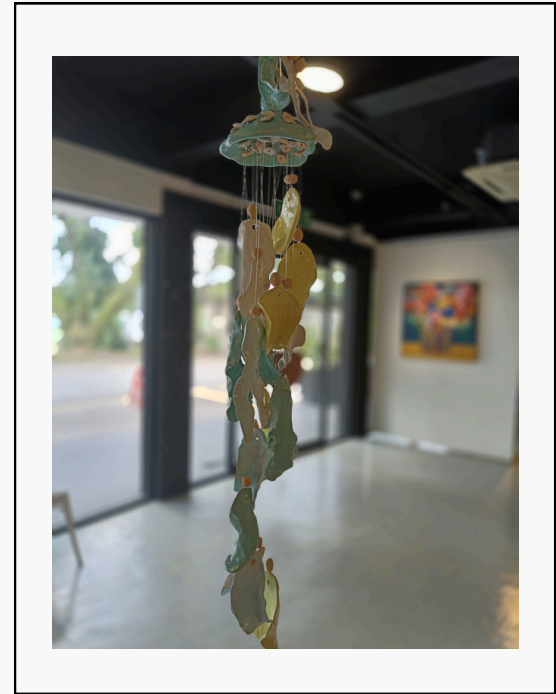
