



## Collegiate Bass Trail of Texas Tournament

**Location: Lake Texoma**

**Weigh-in Site: Lake Texoma (Public Ramp @ the dam)**

**Date: April 22, 2023**

**Entry Due Date:** All entry forms and Release of Liability forms are to be completed and turned in at tournament registration.

**Registration:** All teams must register on Friday, February 17, 2023, at Academy in Sherman 3939 US-75, Sherman, TX 75090 from 5:30 pm to 7:00 pm. Teams will draw for their boat number at check-in/registration and receive their tournament wristband that they have completed check-in/registration. Any changes MUST be made at this time.

**Trailer Event:** 6:30 am to 2:30 pm Boats may leave the ramp of their choice on tournament day with running lights on, life jackets zipped or buckled, kill switch properly attached and students seated properly in the boat. CAN NOT LEAVE RAMP or any BEACHED/DOCKED AREAS BEFORE 5:00 A.M. The tournament Director has the right to remove any boat from competition due to safety violations. The first cast will be at 6:30 am. All lines must be out of the water at 2:30 pm. Teams must be in the weigh-in line by 4:30 pm. Any team not checked in and in line with their fish and/or in line waiting for a sponsor provided clear weigh in bag by 4:30 pm will not be allowed to weigh-in their catch.

**Off Limits:** Any area on the lake with signs or buoys that state "No Fishing", "No Trespassing", "Keep Out", "Off Limits", "No Boats", "No Fishing" or any other similar signage is deemed Off Limits.

**Creel Limit:** For largemouth bass there is no minimum length limit; however, minimum length = 14 inches. There is no length limit on Alabama, Guadalupe or spotted bass. Combined daily bag limit for all species of black bass = 5 fish Tournament Rules: Go to the Collegiate Bass Trail of Texas website for a complete list of the current tournament rules.

**Check-in:** Any team(s) not checked in by 4:30 pm they will be penalized 1 pound per minute for every minute they are late to check-in. Any team(s) returning 15 minutes or more late for their assigned check in >me will not be allowed to weigh-in. **ALL TEAMS MUST CHECK IN, EVEN IF THEY HAVE NO FISH TO WEIGH IN. WE MUST KNOW YOU ARE SAFE AND OFF THE WATER. TEAMS THAT DO NOT CHECK IN WILL RECEIVE 0 POINTS AND WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO FISH ANOTHER CBTT EVENT FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE SEASON PER RULE #17.**

**Weigh-in:** There will be a courtesy board located at the beginning of the holding tanks for teams to check the length of any fish they may intend to weigh-in. Once a team turns over their daily catch to the bump man, the fish are now property of the Collegiate Bass Trail of Texas, and all teams agree to any call by the bump man regarding the official length of all fish. The Tournament Director has the final say in all matters regarding the official length of any fish. There will be 6-8 holding tanks leading up the Official Bump Man. Each tank will have hoses with air diffusers to keep your catch healthy while in line at the holding tanks. Weights will be measured in 1/100ths of a pound for each team (Example: 15.45 lbs).\
