About us

At Sunflowers Pre-School we aim to create a nurturing, stimulating environment for all children in our care. We focus on child-led play, with carefully planned provision and activities to ensure the children are gaining new experiences to extend and support their learning and development.

The environment is set up to allow the children to explore and investigate at their level and in their own time with highly skilled staff supporting and extending their knowledge.

Staff/Key person approach

We use the key person approach at Sunflowers. You will get information on who your child's key person is and more information on what this means during the first week when they are settling in.

Overview of teaching and learning areas of Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)

A plan for each area of the EYFS has been created based upon guidance from 'Birth to 5 matters.'

Children are involved in the planning and shaping of their own learning. Our experienced, skilled staff are guided by their choices when planning for future activities and experiences.

Our floor book is used to record the children's learning as a group. Individual wow walls are used to record children's creations, which could be a painting or a photo of them engaged in play.





Children feel confident and secure from when they first start at the pre-school. They tackle activities with great ambition and vivid imagination.







We use Tapestry online learning journals to share your child's learning with you and invite you to share their home experiences back to us.

More information is provided on the permission letter that you will receive during the admission process.

If your child is attending Thorley Hill's nursery, you will have a separate Tapestry account for this.

You can also pay for your child's sessions. Invoices are sent out termly in advance.

Timetable

Pre-school afternoon session

The pre-school afternoon sessions we provide offer a seamless transition from the morning nursery of Thorley Hill. This makes the 30 hours funding available between these two separate provisions. If your child does not attend the morning session at Thorley Hill they are still very welcome to join us for the afternoon and can do this from their 3rd birthday.

Our opening hours are 11.50am - 3pm and a typical session looks like this:


- Lunch

Preparing your child for Sunflowers

How can you prepare your child?

To enable your child to access the setting fully, encouraging them to be as independent as possible would be good preparation. Guide them through how to put their own coat on, ensuring they have shoes that they can put on and off themselves and are able to open and close their lunch box.

We support all stages of the toilet training process but recommend that you have started to engage the interest at home with your child first.
