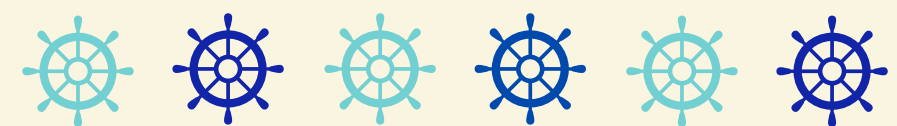


Princess & Pirates Tea Party!!!

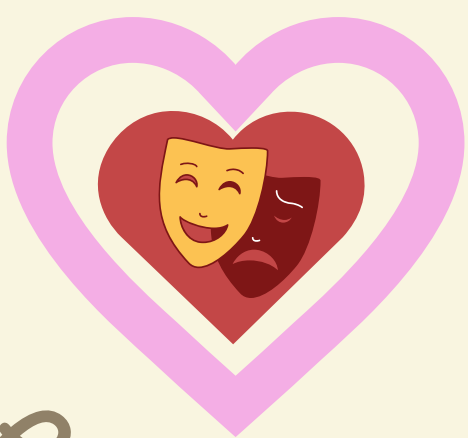
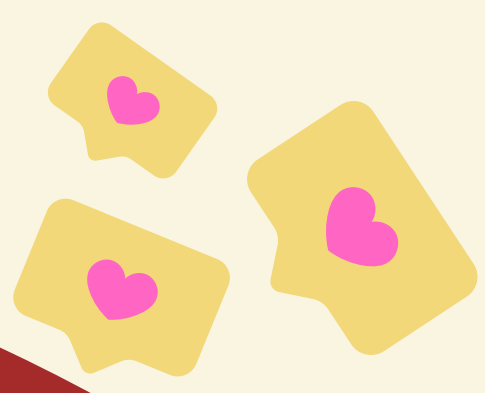
