

Emory J. Mahan Memorial Scholarship

(Sponsored by the Warren County Republican Committee)

INFORMATION & INSTRUCTIONS

The Emory J. Mahan Memorial Scholarships are awarded to selected Warren County high school seniors annually by the Warren County Republican Committee (WCRC). Currently, the scholarship awards are one-time awards in the amount of \$1,000. Recipients are selected primarily on the basis of a competition wherein scholarly essays written by the applicants on a topic determined by the WCRC Scholarship Committee are judged for their conservative values and positive support of our Constitution and Constitutional Republic.

Applicant Eligibility:

1. Must be a resident of Warren County, Pennsylvania
2. Must be a 2020 graduating senior
3. Must have received a letter of acceptance from an accredited University, College, Junior/Community College, or Trade/Technical School
4. Must plan to commence their post-secondary education in the Fall of 2020 if selected to receive the scholarship unless other arrangements are permitted by the WCRC Scholarship Committee.
5. Must submit an application package by the deadline as prescribed below

Submission Requirements:

1. Application (required) with cover letter (if desired)
2. Copy of your Letter of Acceptance from the University, College, Junior/Community College, or Trade/Technical School you have committed to attend
3. A scholarly and well-written essay of approximately 1000 words on the following topic... **"Using the Bill of Rights as a guide, explain and examine the two most important rights you have as an American as well as the two most important duties as an American."**
4. Submission deadline: Thursday, April 23, 2020
