Qualified students shall be considered for a scholarship in the following categories:

High School Graduating Senior intending to enroll in a college, university, technical, trade, or vocational school.

Currently enrolled students in a college, university, technical, trade or vocational school.

- 1. A scholarship applicant need not be of Greek descent.
- 2. A previous AHEPA-Daughters of Penelope District 12 Foundation winner is privileged to receive only one further AHEPA Daughters of Penelope District 12 Foundation scholarship award.
- 3. All applicants must either be enrolled in a full-time program as designated by their college or university or a high school senior preparing to enroll in a full-time program as designated by their college, university, technical, trade, or vocational school that they have chosen to attend.
- 4. The applicant must submit the following documents by March 15, 2026: (a) A completed and signed 2026 scholarship application form. (b) A current official transcript (i.e. stamped and signed by the school the applicant attends) original, scanned and attached to an email. (c) A 350-word essay on the following topic: Describe how your higher education can enable you to help others, while giving back to the community. (d) Current letters of recommendation from two (2) faculty members and one (1) from a member of the community.
- 5. All scholarship application materials—including the application form, official transcript, and supporting documents—must be compiled into a single <u>PDF file</u> (JPEG FILES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED) AND SUBMITTED IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER: (1) Application, (2) Essay, (3) Two letters of recommendation from educators, (4) One letter of recommendation from a community member, (5) Student transcript(s).

ALL APPLICATIONS AND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS MUST BE MARKED BY AN MARCH 15, 2026 EMAIL. APPLICANTS MUST HAVE ALL DOCUMENTATION EMAILED ON OR BEFORE MARCH 15, 2026 TO BE CONSIDERED FOR A SCHOLARSHIP. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE APPLICANT TO CONFIRM THAT THEY HAVE SENT THIS APPLICATION AND ATTACHMENTS BY EMAIL TO THE ABOVE ADDRESS.

- 6. Having met all the requisites above, all applications will be submitted by the Foundation Board to an independent professional educator to determine the winners.
- 7. The scholarship check may be made payable to the applicant or institution.
- 8. If a recipient does not attend the Scholarship Presentation Program in person, or by a parent, or by a grandparent or a family member to accept the scholarship, it may be awarded to an alternate recipient.
